is held at Lincoln Community School at 12th and Jefferson from 7-9 p.m.

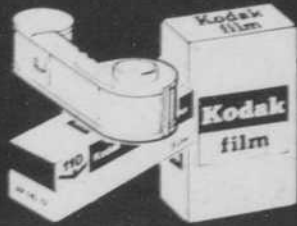
