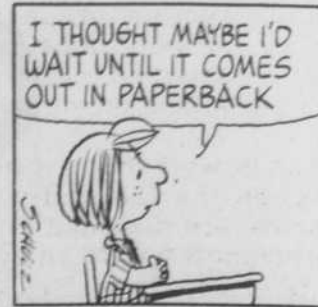

Department head named

Two administrative changes have been made at the University School of Architecture and Allied Arts.

Charles Rusch, head of the architecture department since 1978, has been appointed director of the Center for Environmental Research. Jerry Finrow, associate professor, will replace Rusch as department head.

Finrow, a registered architect, is currently president of the Southwestern Oregon Chapter of the American Institute of Architects. His specialties are de-

sign, research methods and computer applications in architecture. He has been on the University faculty since 1968.

Rusch, on the faculty since 1978, is a specialist in small-town architecture. In 1978, he made a 50-day, 4,145-mile bicycle trip across the United States to take 900 slides of small-town architecture and renovations of old town squares and storefronts.

His appointment is a move to expand the environmental research center's efforts to attain research funding.

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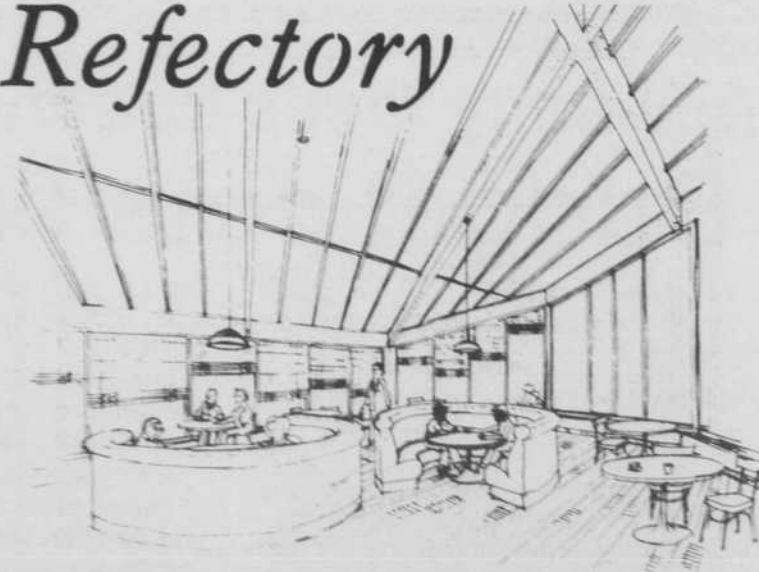
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
