**Two receive internships**

Steven Sechrist and Deborah Abe, senior journalism majors, are among 14 outstanding journalism students from throughout the United States who have been awarded Congressional Internships by Sears, Roebuck and Co.

The interns, scheduled to arrive in Washington, D.C., on Feb. 1, will spend three months serving on the staffs of members of Congress.

They also will attend a series of seminars on "Understanding and Interpreting Legislative Affairs," conducted by Gary Serota, Congressional Man-

agement Foundation director and academic adviser to the interns.

The 14 students were selected by a panel of professional journalists and educators who evaluated applicants on their academic performance, writing ability and interest in political reporting. The interns receive stipends of approximately \$2,000 each.

The goal of the Sears Congressional Internship program, now in its 10th year, is to provide outstanding journalism students with first-hand knowledge of the legislative process.

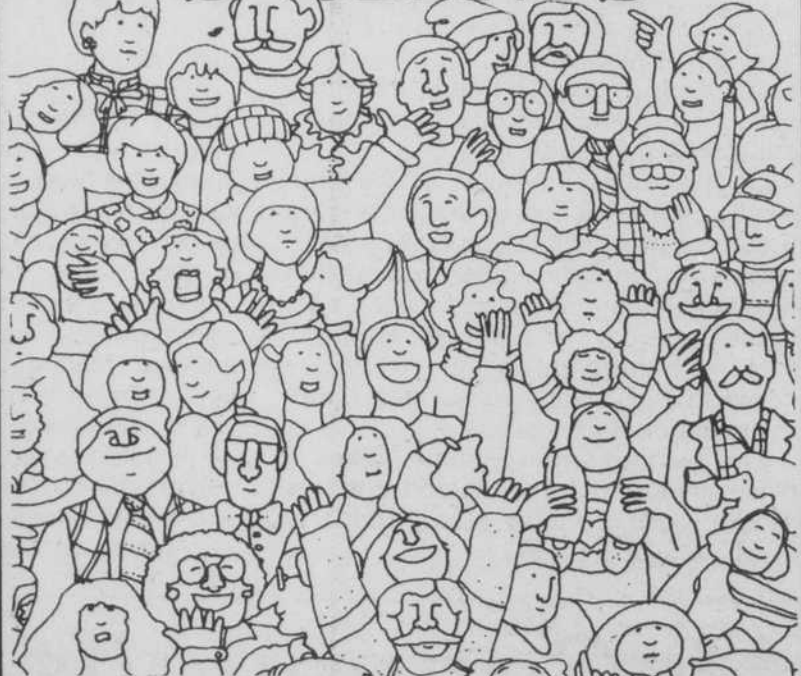
