Four fall to death in platform plunge

VANCOUVER, British Columbia (AP) — Four construction workers plunged to their deaths in downtown Vancouver Wednesday afternoon when a construction platform atop a 36-story building fell to the ground.

An "intensive investigation" into the accident has been initiated by Dominion Construction and the Workers Compensation Board of British Columbia, said David C. Bentall, administrative assistant to the president of Dominion, the victims' employer.

Killed in the 365-foot fall were Yrjo "George" Mitrunen, 47; Gunther Couvreur, 50; Brian Stevenson, 21; and Don Davis, 34, all from the Vancouver area.

The temporary platform was part of the last major construction on the top floor, Bentall said.

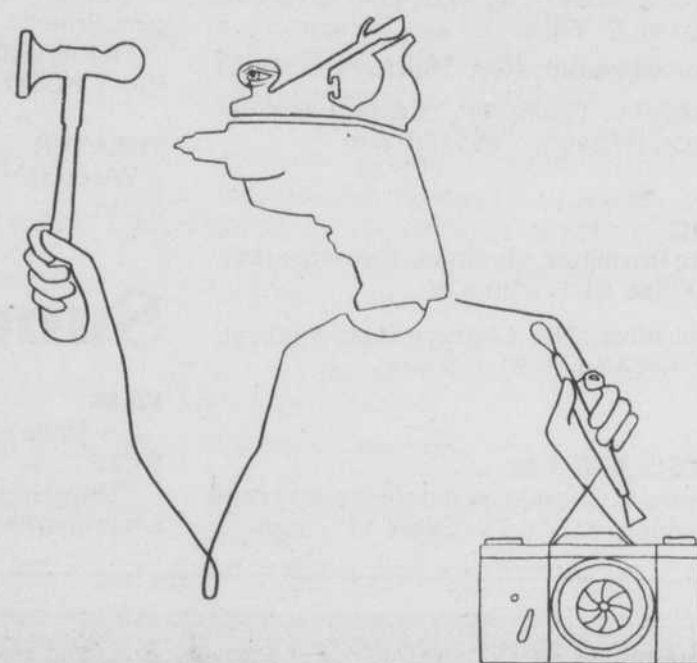
Work on the Bentall Four office tower was halted immediately after the accident.

Dominion spokesmen declined to explain how the platform fell or provide other details of the accident.

"The company can confirm there is no question regarding the structural stability of the building itself," Dominion President R.G. Bentall said.

When completed, the \$60 million project will have 700,000 square feet of offices, the largest such rental space in Vancouver.
