Art historian will discuss Etruscan life

The artifacts and culture of the ancient Etruscan people will be featured in a slide-show presentation tonight at 8 p.m. in Room 107 Lawrence Hall.

Classical historian Michael Grant will speak on "The Etruscans." He will examine the art, culture and origin of the Etruscans, who lived on the central Italian peninsula during the time of the Romans, and will discuss their contribution to Roman culture.

Grant, now retired and living in Italy near the center of ancient Etruria, is the author of 28 books, many on Roman history.

The lecture, a part of the University Visiting Scholars program, is jointly sponsored by the departments of classics, history and art history.
