More than 80 works by one of the nation's foremost printmakers make up the featured exhibit that opened Sunday at the University Museum of Art.

The exhibition, titled "The Collagraph Idea, 1956-1980," contains works by Glen Alps, a University of Washington art professor. The exhibit will in-

clude a photo essay on the techniques of collagraphy.

Museum director Richard Paulin says Alps gained national prominence in 1956 for the development of the collagraphy technique, which is a printmaking process combining various traditional print methods with collage.
