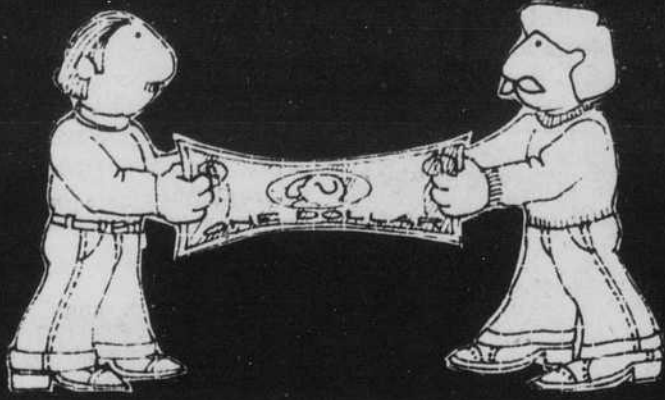

Coming events . . .

In the Eugene-Springfield area, music is rarely missing in the coming events arena. This week is no exception:

- On campus (where there are frequent concerts), the week starts off tonight with a "Musical Smorgasbord" concert to be performed at 12:30 p.m. in Room 198 of the Music School.

Also tonight you can listen to guest saxophone player Brian Minor perform with university pianist Victor Steinhardt at 8 p.m. in Beall Concert Hall.

Tomorrow night Harpsichord student Nancy Selvester will perform her master's degree recital at 8 p.m. in Room 198.

Randy Larson and Doug Walter will direct the University Percussion Ensemble tomorrow night at 8 p.m. in Beall Concert Hall.

The composition department presents a concert of new music by student composers at 8 p.m. in Room 198 on Saturday. Composers represented will be Laura Zaerr, Bill Kleinsasser, Fern McArthur and Albert Ahlstrom.

Featuring a variety of American band music, the University Symphonic Band, directed by Gerald Poe, will perform at 4 p.m. on Sunday in Beall Concert Hall.

Also on Sunday at 4 p.m., soprano Loral Workman, accompanied by Brian Swingle

on piano, will sing songs by Bellini, Purcell and others in the Gerlinger Alumni Lounge.

Later Sunday night, French hornist Kristine Hall will perform her senior recital at 8 p.m. in Beall Concert Hall.

Pianist Dan German and alto saxophonist David Cudo will perform a joint recital Sunday at 8 p.m. in Room 198.

Monday offers a three-part program by the University Singers and special guests, the Gregg Smith Singers of New York City, will be performed at 8 p.m. in Beall Concert Hall.

Jeannine Cansler performs pieces by Frescobaldi, Gabrieli and others in a 12:30 p.m. organ recital in Beall Concert Hall on Tuesday.

Cellist Robert Hladky, assisted by pianist Susan Manoff, will perform in a Faculty Artist Series concert at 8 p.m. in Beall Concert Hall.

The Contemporary Chorus will present a program of American folk music arranged by Robert DeCormier at 8 p.m. Wednesday in Beall Concert Hall.

- Lending an ear a bit off campus, William Ackerman and George Winston will perform a benefit concert for Jazzworkshop Inc. (a non-profit corporation) at 8 p.m. Saturday in the Willamette Room in the Valley River Inn.

Ackerman is considered by many to be one of the finest acoustic guitarists in the country. William has recorded three albums to date, with a fourth due in April. Tickets are \$5 in advance and \$6 on the day of the show.

March 14 Philo recording artist Lisa Neustadt and the Angel Band from the greater Boston area will perform at the Wesley Center (1236 Kincaid St.)

- Elvin Bishop comes to Oregon March 13 and 14 — though you'll have to drive 109 miles (or so) to see him with the Liquid Blues Band at the Euphoria in Portland. Tickets are
