## Final auditions will be held for musicians

The auditions will begin at 8:30 a.m. each day and are open to the public.

Selection of finalists was based on preliminary screening conducted by University music school faculty. Approximately \$55,000 will be awarded in amounts of \$1,000, \$2,000 and \$3,000 for full-time students of harp, voice, keyboard, all orchestral instruments, composition, music history or music education.
