An author of more than 40 papers on human potential and career development for women, Matthews views her philosophy as a radical change in the way people customarily view each other.

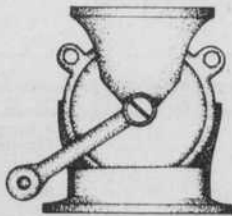

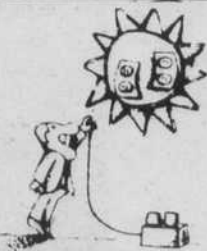
