Seven crew members aboard the spacecraft Nostromo are awakened from hypersleep by the ship's computer to investigate what seems to be a distress signal coming from a nearby planet. By the time they discover that the signal is actually a warning it is too late: an alien creature, virtually indestructible and totally hostile, has attached itself to a crew member and gained access to the ship. One by one, the alien relentlessly stalks the crew throughout the claustrophobic confines of the ship, and their efforts to destroy it seem doomed to failure. Director Ridley Scott (THE DUELLISTS) has fashioned a stunningly visual nightmare where terror lurks in every corner and there is literally nowhere to turn. ALIEN is scary and stylish science fiction at its best.
