THE DUELLISTS

Ridley Scott's film debut and a winner at Cannes, is a darkly sumptuous period film about obsession. Keith Carradine and Harvey Keitel star as two Hussar officers in Napoleon's army who violently confront each other in a series of savage duels. The duels begin as a reaction to a minor incident and escalate into a consuming passion which rules the lives of both men for a period of 30 years. Based
