

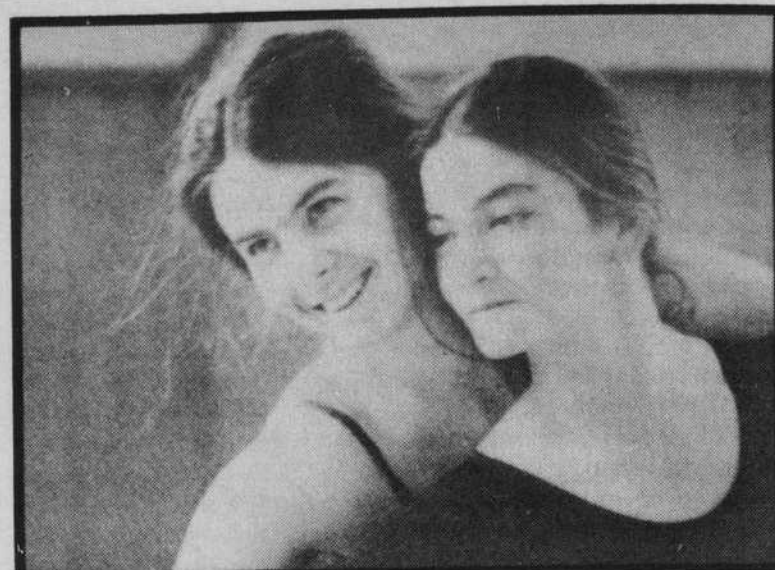
Coming events . . .

Showtimes are 7 and 10 p.m. Tickets are \$6 in advance and \$7 at the door. CCPA Members get a \$1 discount.

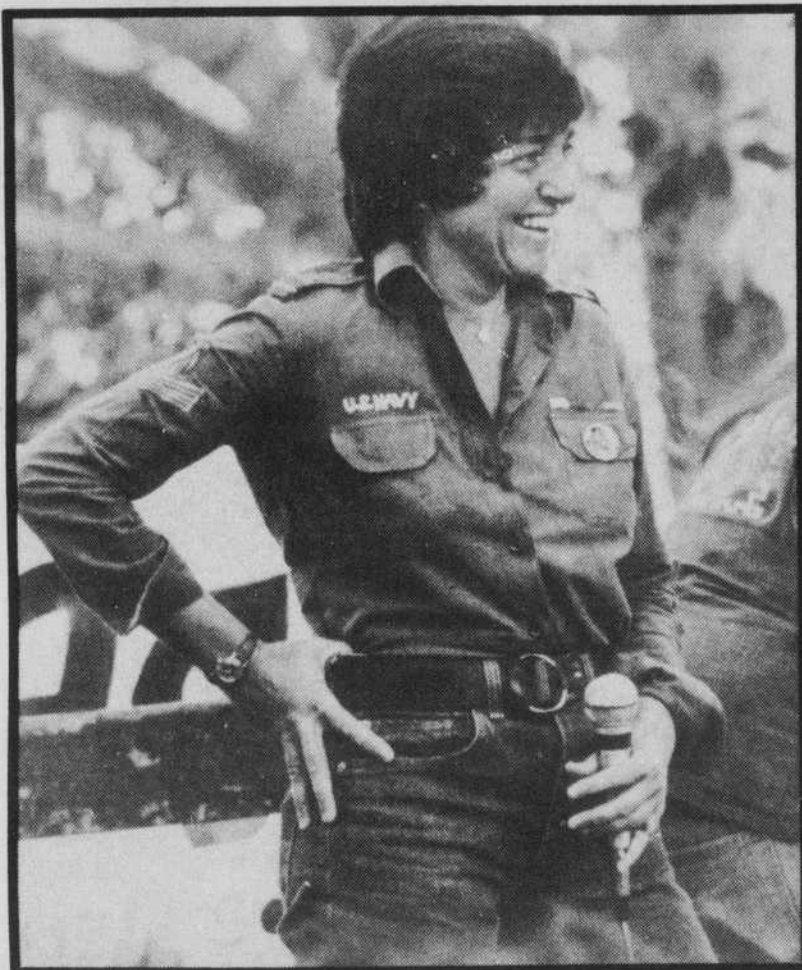


Dancing for El Salvador

Gay Pride '81: It's a Faire!

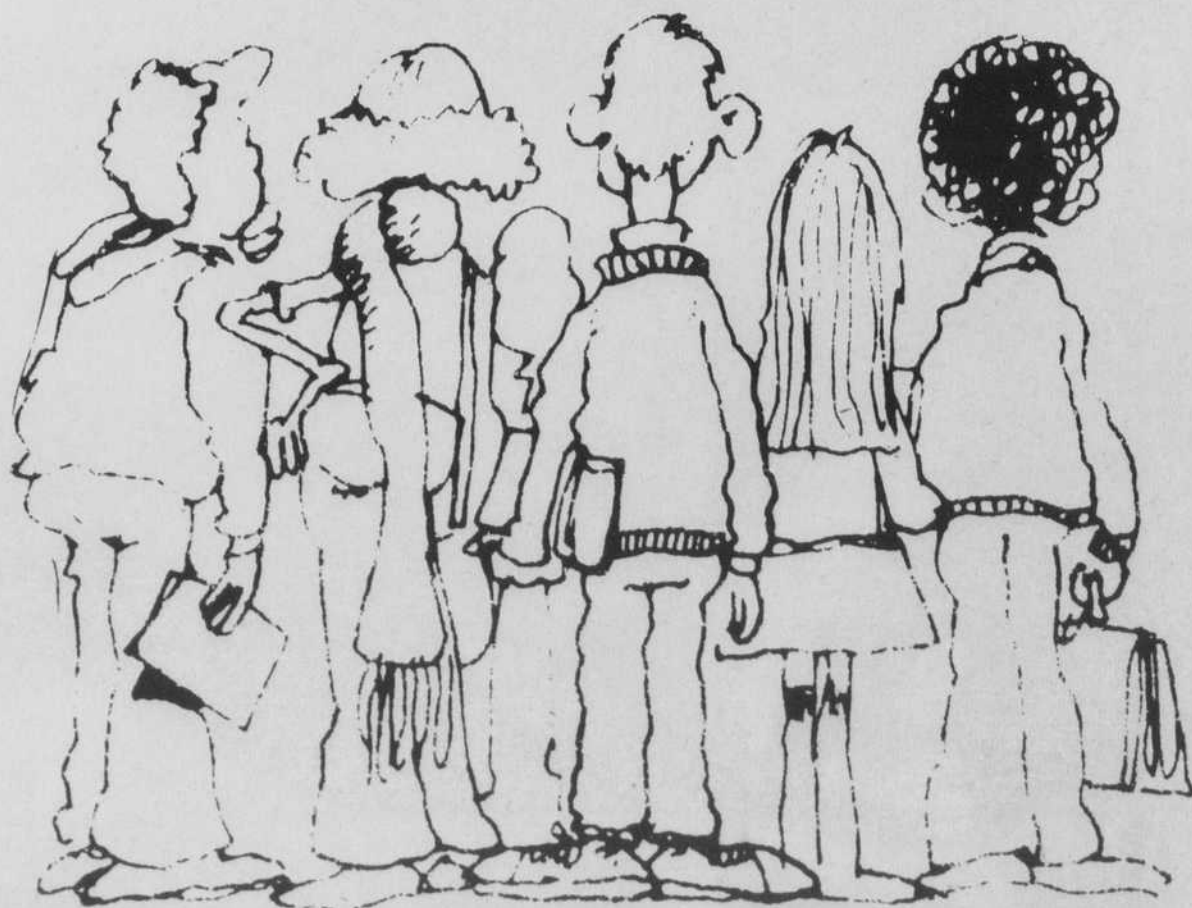
