

University vets slate conference for veterans of Vietnam conflict

The second annual Western Regional Conference of Vietnam Era Veterans will be held Friday through Sunday.


Sponsored by the University Veterans Association, the event is designed to provide a platform for discussion of issues related to Vietnam veterans. Topics will include renewed American militarism, the draft, Agent Orange defoliant poisoning, delayed stress response syndrome, legislation and political activism, women and minorities, and employment issues.

"We see the purpose of the conference to be


two-fold," says University Veterans director Dave Isenberg. "First, we hope to unite veteran and Vietnam veteran self-help organizations for the purpose of sharing information and, second, to establish a power base of Vietnam veteran organizations to affect humanistic change legislatively, politically and socially."
