## Hart heads Demo meet

Sen. Gary Hart, D-Colorado, will be keynote speaker at the Oregon Democratic Party's 1981 Grass Roots Conference, scheduled for today and Saturday on the Western Oregon State College campus in Monmouth.

Hart, George McGovern's campaign manager during the 1972 Presidential campaign, will be the special guest of Rep. Les AuCoin, D-Ore., during the weekend. Hart will attend two receptions and will be the main speaker at the Saturday night banquet.

Topics to be discussed at this

year's conference will include government productivity, civil liberties and energy development. A total of 15 small group workshops will be conducted on Saturday. The workshops will converge into three larger sessions under the headings of Human Resources, Government and Finance, and Natural Resources.

Registration opens at 3 p.m. on the main floor of WOSC's College Center.

The registration package, which includes Saturday lunch and the banquet that evening, is \$20. The basic fee is \$4.

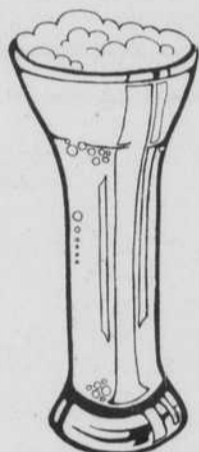
