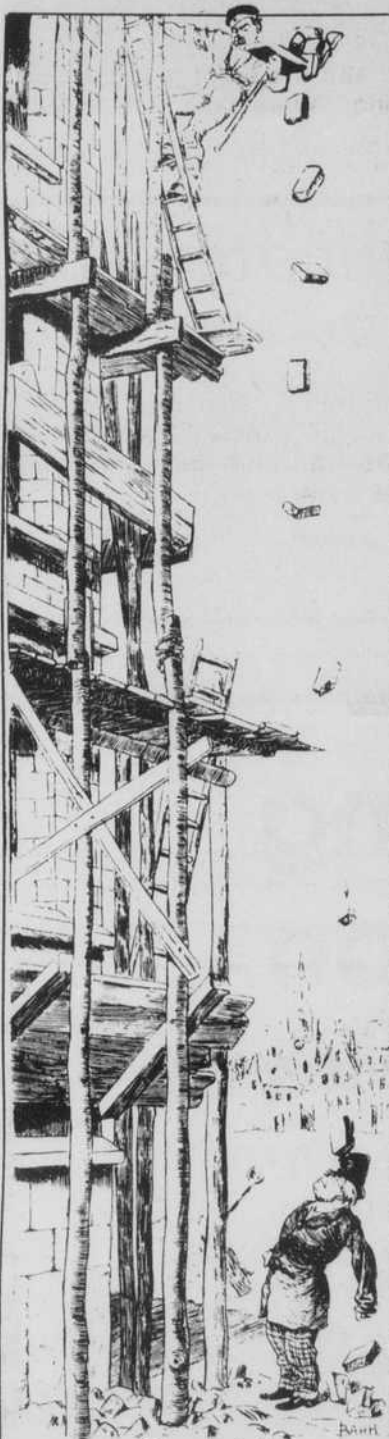


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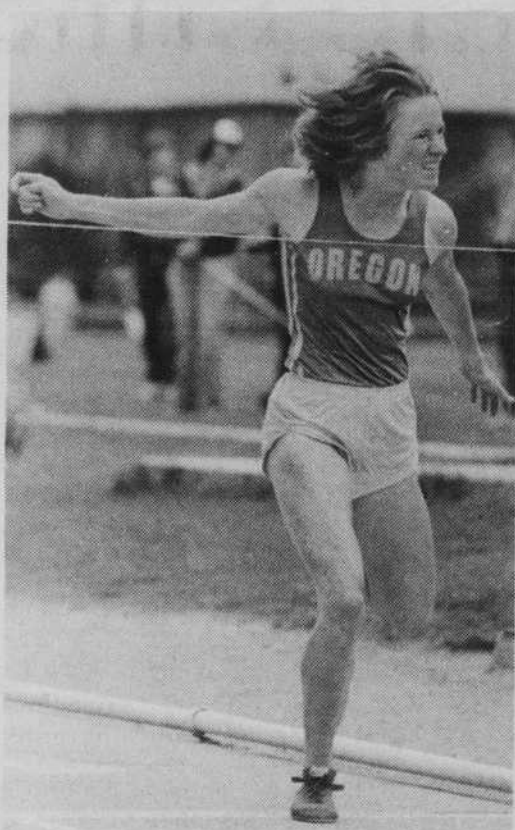

Oregon will look for some big points from distance star Leann Warren...

Australian set an Oregon record of 9:22.4 in the 3,000 last Sunday on a hot Berkeley track.

In the case of long-distance runner Eryn Forbes, Heinonen is still deciding whether she will run the 5,000 or 10,000. Forbes' best time at each distance (16:07.7, 33:55.8) equals the sixth-place time at last year's nationals.

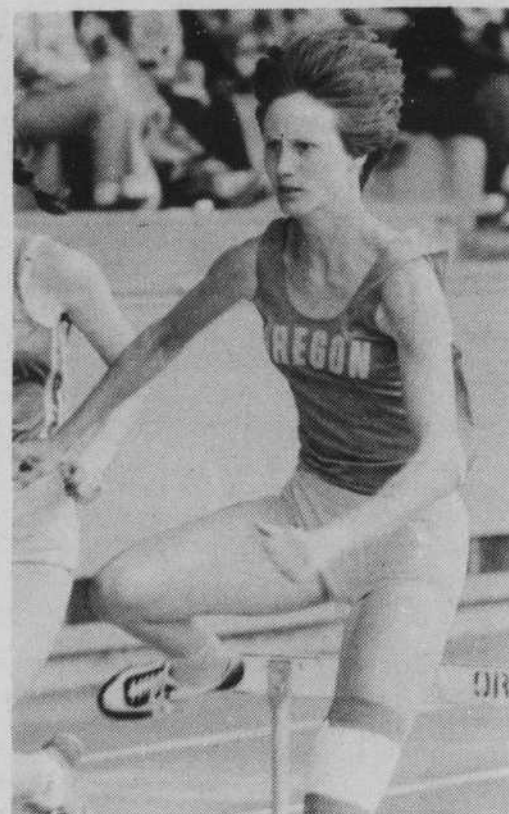
In the field events, javelin thrower Sally Harmon "has as good chance as anybody, except Leann, to score," Heinonen says. "In our second most important meet of the season (the Northwest championships), she beat three of the top throwers in the nation (Teri Cooper, Jeanne Eggart and Deanna Carr)."

Harmon also set her season best at that meet, throwing 168-5.

Another Oregon thrower, discus specialist Karen McDonald, added almost three feet to her personal best at Berkeley with a 173-8.

"We clearly have a chance to score in every event where we have a qualifier," says Heinonen, adding that several people hover around that one-point sixth place.

"Looking at it one way, we could score 40 points. Looking at it another way, we could get 19 again."
