Center gets new system

Zollner wins cash prize for choral music talent

Patricia Zollner, a senior music major, is the 1981 recipient of the Max Risinger Award which recognizes the music student who shows "promise of outstanding success" in choral music education.

Zollner, 24, won the cash prize based on her talent and performance in choral music education, according to music education Prof. Gary Martin, who chaired the selection committee. The award was announced Sunday, during an evening performance by the University Singers.

A student teacher at Bailey Hill Elementary and Kennedy Junior High Schools in Eugene, Zollner will teach music and direct the choral music program at St. Dominico Grade School and Parish in Los Angeles.

Established in memory of Max Risinger, a member of the University music faculty from 1954 to 1975, the award is granted annually to a junior, senior or graduate student in choral music education. It is made possible by private gifts to the University Foundation from Risinger's widow and others.

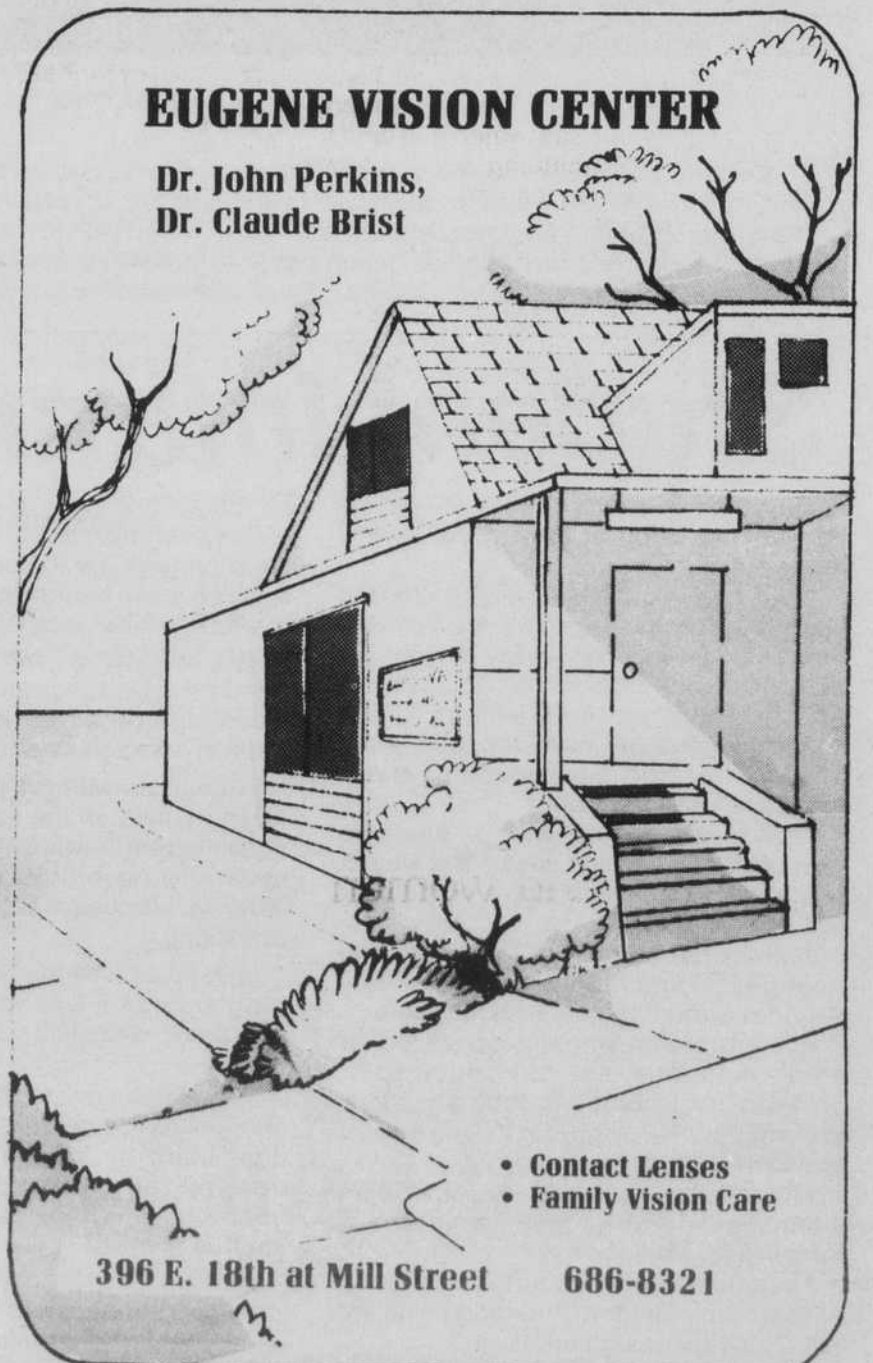
