

# City slates summer outdoor music series

Summer's here and the time is right for dancing in the park. The Eugene Parks and Recreation Department is sponsoring a series of 17 free concerts in city parks this summer. The series includes concerts at Skinner Butte Park on

Sunday afternoons and at Amazon Park on Thursday nights. Highlighting the Skinner Butte Park concerts will be the reggae band Native Pulse on July 26, the Lon Guitarski Group on August 9 and a blues jam on

Sept. 13. Just Friends, an Irish folk group, will appear at Amazon Park on July 23. The Sunday concerts start at 1:30 p.m. and the Thursday night gigs at 7:00. In other summertime activities, the Sheldon Community

Center is offering a series of four family raft floats. The trips will be on Wednesdays July 15 and 23 and Aug. 12 and 26, between 5:30 and 8:30 p.m. starting at Alton Baker Park.

The cost is \$6 per person and all equipment is provided. No one under the age of eight is allowed to participate. For information on registration, call the center at 687-5312.

The Parks and Recreation Department is offering an overnight bike tour to Alsea Falls July 18-19. The fee is \$10 and participants should register by

July 8. A series of comprehensive bicycle repair workshops will be taught by the Parks and Recreation Department starting July 10. The seven-week program meets on Fridays between 9 and noon at the Campbell Senior Center, 155 High Street.

Participants will learn how to disassemble and assemble their bikes as well as how to do periodic maintenance. The cost is \$20. For information on the workshop or the bike tour, call the bicycle program at 687-5329.
