## History professor passes away

Kenneth Porter, an award-winning poet and University professor emeritus of history, died recently at the age of 76.

Porter joined the University's history department as a full-time professor in 1958 and retired in 1972. He earned a bachelor's degree at Sterling College, a master's degree at the University of Minnesota and a doctorate at Harvard University. His academic specialty was the

social history of the American frontier, particularly as it involved racial, ethnic and religious groups.

Following two years teaching history and political science at Southwestern College, Winfield, Kan., he served 10 years on the history faculty at Vassar College, Poughkeepsie, N.Y. He filled visiting professorships at Oregon in 1951-52, at the University of Illinois, Urbana, in

1955-58, and at Arizona State University in 1972-73.

Porter, who was a Fulbright lecturer on American history and institutions at Melbourne University in Australia during 1954, also was a research associate and special director of research for the Business History Foundation, Inc. He traveled extensively, visiting such countries as Indonesia, Egypt and Northern Ireland.
