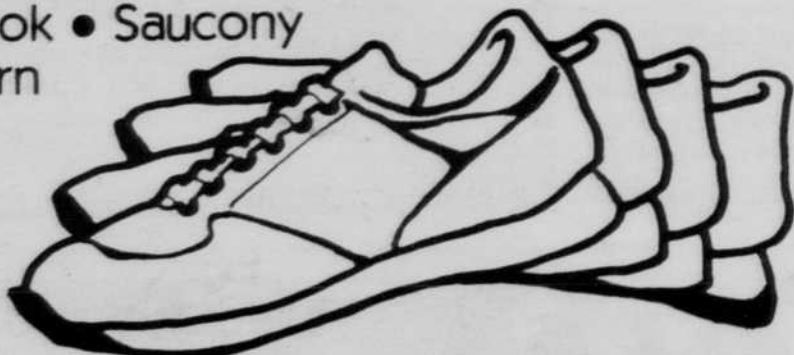

## Several agencies sell birth control

Students in need of birth control can contact one of several clinics in Eugene that offer family planning and counseling.

Most of the clinics offer pregnancy testing, pap smears, breast and pelvic exams and routine lab tests for moderate to low fees. In addition, the clinics provide birth control devices or the necessary prescriptions.

- Planned Parenthood is located at 134 E. 13th Ave. Business hours are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Clinic hours are noon to 7 p.m. Mondays and Thursdays and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

A routine examination that costs \$28 is required before birth control methods are prescribed.

Appointments are necessary. Call 344-9411 or 344-1611.

- The Community Health and Education Center (CHEC) is located at 433 W. 10th Ave. Business hours are 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

A \$23 fee is charged for an initial examination and additional fees are charged for lab tests.

Call 485-5782 for appointments.

- The Wallama Medical Center is located at 1140 Patterson St. Business hours are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

A \$20 fee is charged for initial visits. Oral contraceptives sometimes are dispensed free of charge.

Call 342-6545 for appointments.

- Lane County Family Planning is located at 401 E. 10th Ave., Suite 3 E. Business hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Services include routine examinations and pregnancy tests. Fees are charged on a sliding-scale basis.

For appointments, call 687-4361.

- The University Student Health Center is located on the corner of 13th Avenue and Agate Street. Business hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

The center provides family planning care as well as all forms of contraception.

No fees are charged to students, and the Center pharmacy fills prescriptions at lower rates than usual.
