## NCAA to continue scrutiny

The University has received the long-expected letter of official inquiry from the National Collegiate Athletic Association, University officials said Wednesday.

The letter represents the next phase of the athletic department investigation initiated by the University in late 1979, says Ray Hawk, vice president for administration and finance.

"As a result of our internal investigation, the University took action concerning some of its employees and declared certain athletes ineligible under Pac-10 and NCAA rules," Hawk says.

The University's investigation covered five areas: the possible violation of University academic integrity; the conduct of athletic department employees; the possible ineligibility of student athletes; the extent of telephone misuse; and what could be done to improve internal procedures.

The University asked the NCAA to further investigate the matter, and gave the association materials gathered in the University investigation, Hawk says.

The letter received Wednesday indicates the NCAA has completed its preliminary investigation and has moved to the official inquiry phase, which consists of the University examining the NCAA's findings as they relate to NCAA rules and regulations.

University officials have until Jan. 18 to reply.
