Registration for ESCAPE accepted through Friday

The ESCAPE Field Studies Program — a student-managed program placing student volunteers in Eugene area community service agencies — has extended its registration deadline through Friday.

Students are needed to fill hundreds of requests for volunteer help in local day care centers, public and private schools and nursing homes. ESCAPE is an accredited academic program, and students earn practicum credit through the Wallace School of Community Service and Public Affairs.

"I don't think students are aware that there is an opportunity to gain experience and

gain credit," says Trudy Flannery, ESCAPE student director. "Especially with budget cuts, a lot of agencies are relying on volunteer help."

Dwindling federal and state support for Eugene area community service agencies has heightened the need for volunteers, adds deShauna Blankenship, Community Services Division director.

Volunteers are needed in each of ESCAPE's three divisions: the Community Service Division, the Public Schools Division and the Bethel School Project.

Students typically agree to work between three to nine hours per week and earn one practicum credit for every three on-the-job hours.

"People are feeling pressured to graduate in four years," Blankenship says. Consequently, many students are reluctant to enroll in courses outside the traditional offerings in their majors. "They don't realize how valuable getting experience is," she says.

The 12-year-old program instructs about 1,500 students per year. ESCAPE usually fills about half of the approximately 700 requests for volunteer help it receives each term.

Registration will be open from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. through Friday at the ESCAPE office, 327 EMU. Call campus extension 4351 for more information.
