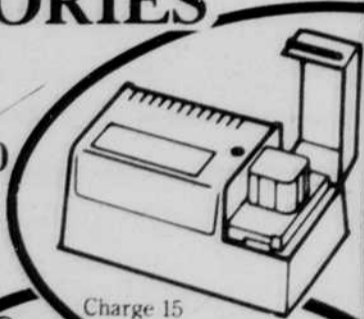

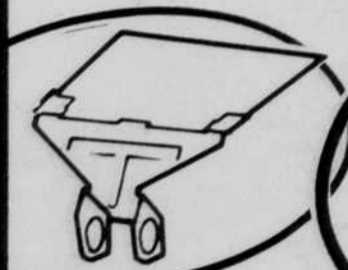

Oregon sweeps Cougars

The Oregon volleyball team captured its first league victory of the season, dumping Washington State in three games last weekend.

The Ducks fell earlier in to the University of Montana and Montana State to drop their record to 8-21-2.

"It was a real delight to beat Washington State," said Oregon coach, Chris Voelz. "It's been a while since we've played well and gotten a win. We've had some good games, but winning them has eluded us."

"It has been difficult to have so many setbacks and still be able to come back and play the kind of game we did against WSU. We were loose and confident, which enabled us to do the things we needed to do to

get the win."

"Against the Montana teams, we didn't help ourselves any and ended up beating ourselves. That changed against WSU and we ended up playing some of our best ball of the season."

Cathy Hill, playing despite tendonitis in her knees, has been outstanding for Oregon. By using a new anti-inflammatory drug and taping her knees differently, Hill has been much more mobile on the court.

"Cathy has always been a real

workhorse on the court, but now with her new mobility, she's been brilliant for us," said Voelz. "She is doing now what we always knew she was capable of, but was prevented to do because of her knees. She has been nothing less than amazing."

Karen Beamer has really helped the Ducks after recovering from her own knee injury. She leads the league in blocks, with Hill not far behind in third place, which pushes Oregon into the lead in team blocks.

Monday homer lifts L.A.

Dodgers face Yanks in Series

MONTREAL (AP) — Rick Monday's two-out home run in the top of the ninth inning today propelled the Los Angeles Dodgers past the Montreal Expos 2-1 Monday and into the World Series.

The victory in the fifth and final game of the National League championship series, postponed one day after Sunday's 3½-hour rain delay, sends the Dodgers to New York, where they will open the World Series Tuesday night against the American League champions, the Yankees, in a rematch of the 1977 and 1978 classics.

Ray Burris, who outpitched Fernando Valenzuela in the second game of this series, winning 3-0, hooked up with him again, allowing five hits in eight innings before the Expos pinch hit for him.

Steve Rogers, the hero of Montreal's first playoff when he beat Philadelphia's Steve Carlton twice in the NL East series, got the first two outs in the ninth. But Monday connected on a 3-1 pitch and sent it over the center field wall.

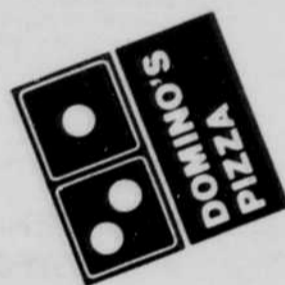
