

Haig's clothes cover other shortcomings

NEW YORK (AP) — The best dressed man in the U.S. government is Secretary of State Alexander Haig, in the opinion of the Custom Tailor's Guild.

In giving Haig top honors over President Reagan in the statesman category on its list of America's 10 best-dressed men, the guild said Wednesday the secretary of state "has done much to repair the image of American tailors throughout the world and has given a needed shot in the arm to the men's clothing industry abroad."

Deploing the dress habits of Reagan, Alfonso Caprio, president of the guild said: "He simply doesn't know how to dress, therefore seldom looks

presidential. He ought to consult with Mr. Haig every morning about what to wear."

The guild named Walter Cronkite "All-American" dresser.

Robert Wagner and Monty Hall tied for being best clad in television, while John Travolta captured the award for the movie industry.

The citation for the field of comedy went to Don Rickles.

Other winners were Barry Manilow in the music category; Mikhail Baryshnikov in dance; Tony Dorsett in sports; Carl Blonn, an industrial parts manufacturer, in the industry category, and Vito Pascucci, head of LeBlanc Corp. of Kenosha, Wis., in business.

'Buffalypsos' mooove into Key West

KEY WEST, Fla. (AP) — A cross between beef cattle and buffalo is called "Beefalo," but now there's something called the "Buffalypso."

That's the name given by Wyland Cripe of the University of Florida to a breed of water buffalo he is importing from the

island of Trinidad — Calypso country — hence Buffalypso.

Cripe is working to see how the animals fare in the swamps of the two coastal states.

One hundred Buffalypso are in Key West, where they are being held for 30 days of observation before transfer to

ranches in Florida and Louisiana as part of a cattle-raising experiment.

The animals, weighing between 900 and 1,500 pounds, are in the care of Cripe. "They're magnificent animals," he says. "We know the meat is excellent."
