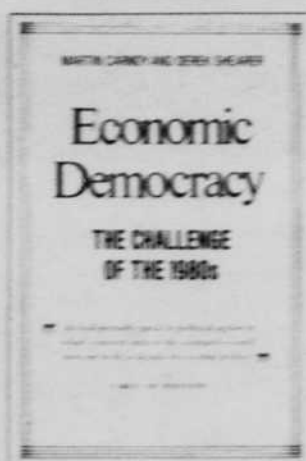

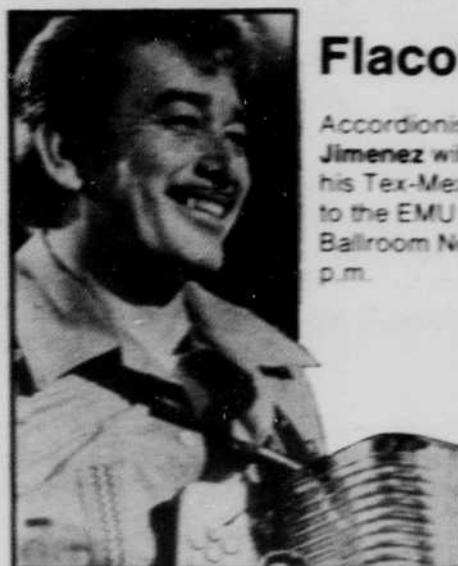
How can we achieve economic democracy?
