## Former Yale president to speak at graduation

Hanna Halborn Gray, president of the University of Chicago, has accepted an invitation to be the commencement speaker at the University's spring commencement.

"We wanted our commencement speaker this year to be both a leading scholar and an outstanding representative of American higher education. Hanna Gray is both of these things," University Pres. Paul Olum said.

"She was our first choice and we are delighted she has accepted."

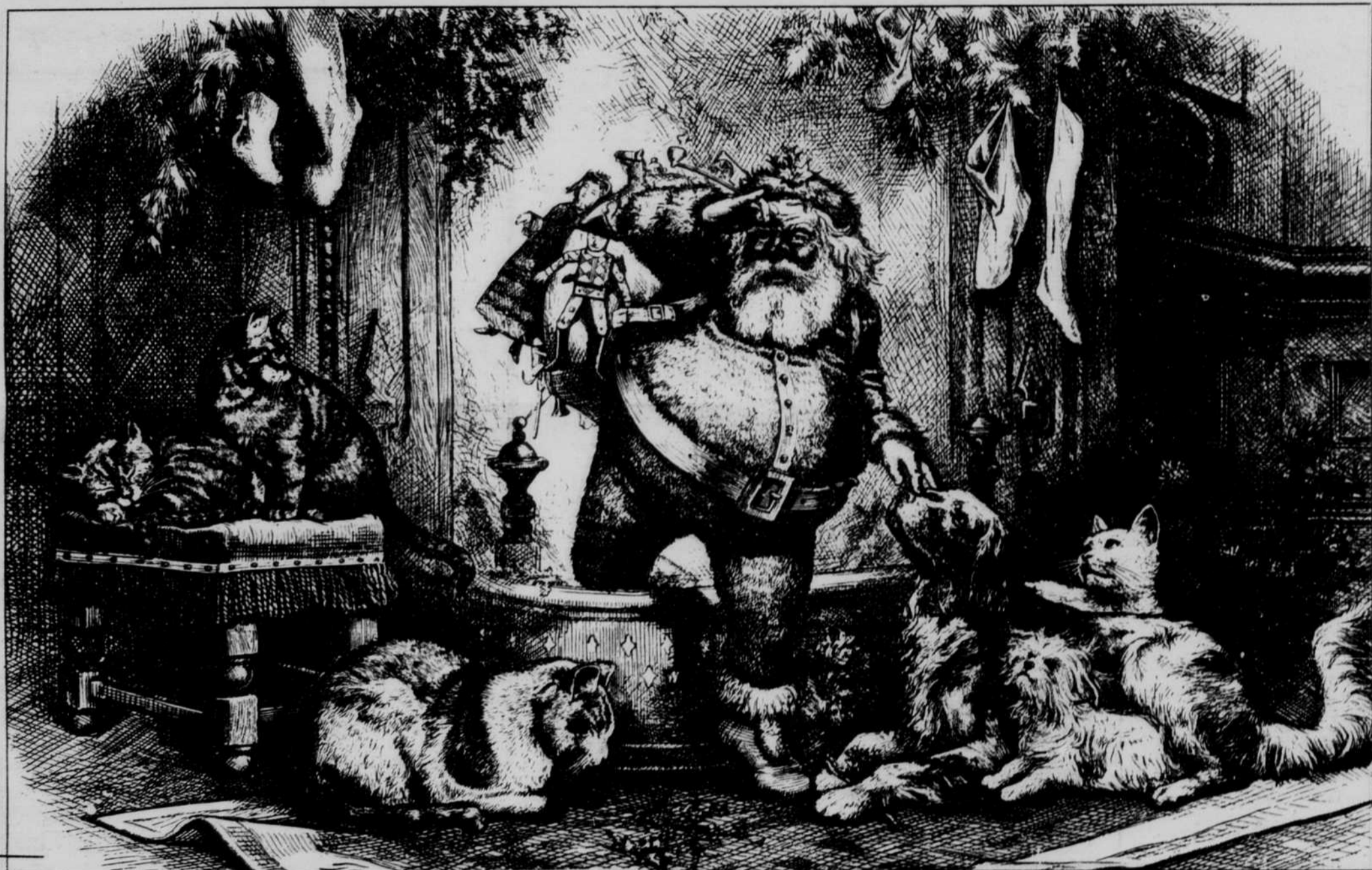
Gray is the first woman to serve as chief executive officer of a major American co-educational institution of higher ed-

ucation. Gray assumed the post at Chicago in July 1978 after serving as provost and then acting president of Yale University.

Gray entered Bryn Mawr College in Pennsylvania at the age of 15, completed her bachelor of arts degree summa cum laude in 1950, went to Oxford University as a Fulbright scholar and completed a doctoral degree in history at Harvard University.

A member of Phi Beta Kappa and a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, Gray is a scholar of Renaissance and Reformation history. She has taught at Harvard and the University of Chicago.
