

Men host powerful AIA club

The Ducks will be thrown to the Christians tonight.

One of the most successful amateur basketball teams in the nation, Athletes-in-Action, matches up against the Oregon men at 7:30 p.m. in an exhibition game in McArthur Court.

Athletes-in-Action, a group of Christian ex-college players who play major college teams across the nation, enter into tonight's contest with a 6-5 record this season, fresh off a double-overtime victory over undefeated Idaho Saturday and a 63-56 loss to unbeaten Oregon State on Monday night.

Oregon enters the game, which will not count on the team's record, with a 2-1 mark. The Ducks lost their opener to Cal-Irvine, 90-84, before winning their next two games over Cal-Riverside (100-89) and St. Martin's (63-56).

Oregon head coach Jim Haney will probably start the same five as he has in the first three games: 7-0 Blair Rasmussen at center, 6-8 Jerome Williams and 6-7 John Greig at forwards, and 6-3 guards Fred Cofield and Gary Gatewood. Williams is the Ducks leading scorer with 17.0 p.p.g.

AIA features an experienced starting five of 6-9 Gig Sims (ex-UCLA) at center, 6-7 Dan Frost (Iowa) and 6-9 Dave Johnson (Weber St.) at forwards, and 6-1 Steve Botranger (Oral Roberts) and 6-3 Phil Price (Taylor University) at guards. Johnson is the team leader in scoring (14.6 p.p.g.) and rebounding, while Botranger is second on the team in scoring (12.4 p.p.g.).

Tonight's game is the first of three in four days for the Ducks. After tomorrow night's contest vs. Rhode Island, Oregon makes its first road trip of the season to San Diego State for a Saturday night game.
