## Christians sponsor forum

Mars Hill Forum — a weekly program modeled loosely after C.S. Lewis' Socratic Club — begins today at noon with a panel discussion, "Christians in Politics: Models of Power and Servanthood."

The Restoration Campus Ministry and the Eugene-Springfield chapter of Evangelicals for Social Action are sponsoring the series to give the University what the Socratic Club gave Oxford University: an intriguing interchange on a wide range of issues.

"Bible-believing Christians aren't all necessarily from the Moral Majority," says Dick Beswick of the Restoration Campus Ministry, adding that the forum is designed to address diverse areas from a Christian perspective.

Forums will be held Fridays from noon until 1:30 p.m. in the

"Christians in Politics," today's panel discussion, includes short presentations by John Hubbard of FISHPAC, Steve Samson of Salt Shakers, Ted Grimsrud of Christians for Peace and Justice, Doug Groothuis of McKenzie Study Center, and Beswick.

"War and Pacifism in the Old Testament," on Jan. 22, brings professor Millard Lind of Menonite Seminary in Indiana to Eugene.

Northwest Christian College Prof. David Root speaks Jan. 29 on the "New Testament Basis for Social Justice."

Tom Sine, of World Concern in Seattle, will speak on "Evangelicals for Social Action" at the Feb. 5 forum.

"Christianity, Free Enterprise, and Third World Development"

will be presented Feb. 12 by Wes Morgan of the Institute for International Development.

A debate between creationist Norm Fox and David Wagner, curator of the University's natural history museum, on "Creation/Evolution: Science or Religion" takes place Feb. 19.

Jerry Riley, candidate for Oregon House District 39, gives part two of "New Testament Basis for Social Justice" on Feb. 26.

"Authority of the Scriptures — Inspiration and Inerrancy" is Jack Crabtree's topic for the Mar. 5 forum.

George Bryson, KBMC talk show moderator, and Beswick lead a discussion Mar. 12 on "Cults: East and West."

Wes Michaelson, former editor of Sojourner's magazine and aide to Sen. Mark Hatfield, R-Ore., speaks about "Peacemaking with God, Others and the Earth" on Mar. 19.

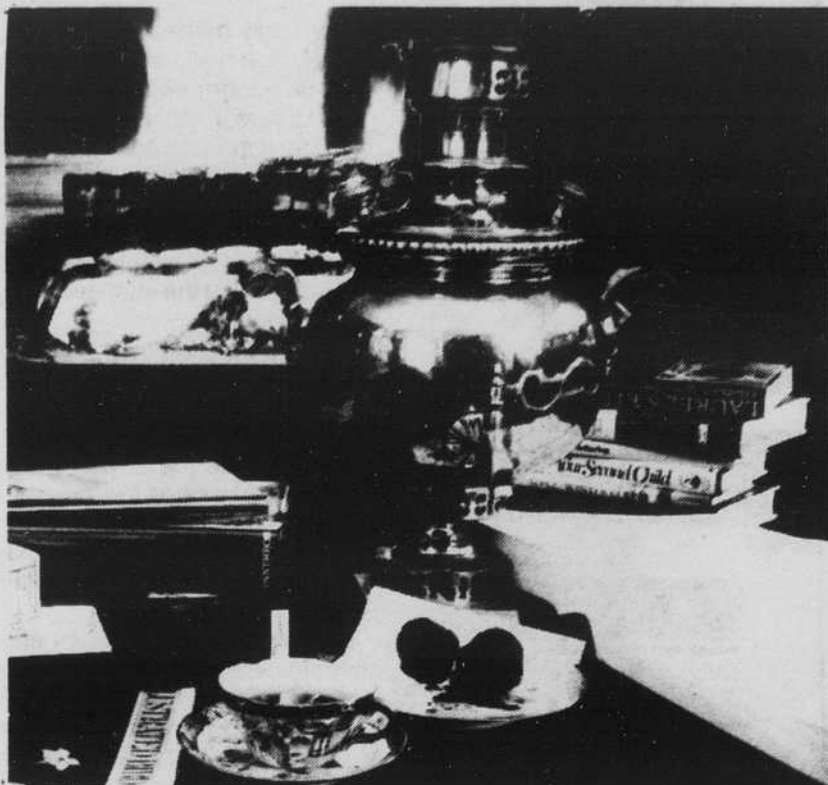
