Americans oppose ban on abortion

NEW YORK

Nine years after the U.S. Supreme Court legalized abortion, 3 of 4 Americans oppose a constitutional amendment which would allow Congress to ban abortions, according to the latest Associated Press-NBC News poll.

The nationwide telephone poll, of 1,597 adults in a scientific random sampling on Monday and Tuesday, asked, "Do you favor or oppose an amendment to the Constitution which would give Congress the authority to prohibit abortions?"

Seventy-five percent said they oppose a constitutional amendment, 19 percent said they favored a constitutional

amendment and 6 percent were not sure.

There was also strong support among respondents for two positions espoused by abortion rights groups.

Fifty-seven percent said they agree with the statement, "Every woman who wants to have an abortion should be able to have one."

And 77 percent said they agree with the statement, "The decision to have an abortion should be left to the woman and her physician." The 77 percent included 59 percent who said they "strongly" support that position and 18 percent who "mildly" favor it.

Atiyeh offers timber proposal

Companies could pay about

30 percent less than they bid to harvest state timber sales this year under a proposal by Gov. Vic Atiyeh to stimulate the wood products industry and prevent sale defaults.

State Forester Mike Miller told the Senate Revenue Committee on Wednesday that Atiyeh's proposal (SB985) would allow him to roll back the stumpage price on a sale or to grant a one year extension. The measure is part of the governor's economic recovery plan.

Miller said the adjusted stumpage price would be equal to the current appraised value multiplied by the original bid-up factor. He said in most cases this would average 30 percent to 35 percent less than the original stumpage price.

He said companies seeking a one-year extension to avoid harvesting timber during the housing market slump would have to give the state an advance payment equal to 40 percent of the unpaid balance on the sale.

Polish union remains active

WARSAW, Poland

Informed union sources said Thursday that Solidarity militants launched an underground movement and a newspaper, and Poland's hardline army daily accused the activists of using working people "as a ramrod to smash their way to their target."

Solidarity sources said workers in at least one major factory, the Huta Warszawa steel mill, started a movement called the Workers' Committee for Social Self-Defense and an underground paper.

Poland's army newspaper, *Zolnierz Wolnosci*, said that "angry" counter-revolutionary elements from Solidarity had not conceded defeat after the union was suspended and martial law declared Dec. 13 following 16 months of labor upheaval.

Authorities reported Tuesday they had uncovered an "illegal" Solidarity publishing house in southwestern Wroclaw that contained printing presses and leaflets calling for "insubordination... and undertaking activities against existing law."
