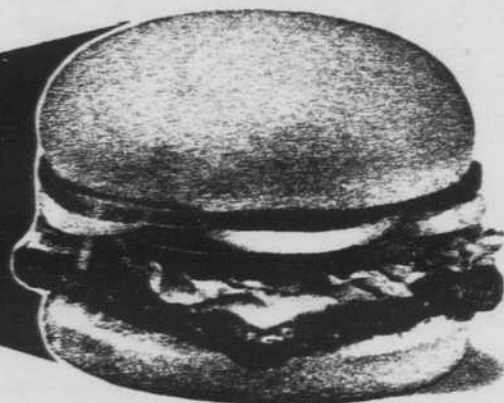

Judge finds OCE guilty of sex bias

Portland — Oregon College of Education administrators discriminated against six women faculty members in establishing their salaries, U.S. District Judge Helen Frye has ruled.

Frye said the salary differences between six of the women plaintiffs and male faculty members in comparable jobs "can only be explained on the basis of sex."

She ordered that the college — which has since changed its name to Western Oregon State College — pay attorneys' fees and back wages and fringes benefits from July 10, 1976 to the present.

The Judge also said that statistical evidence on the salaries of the school's faculty "does show a pattern of differences between the salaries of men and women."

"In all ranks at OCE from 1975 to 1980, mens salaries were higher than womens salaries," she said.

College officials declined to comment on the opinion until they speak with their attorneys.

The school's attorneys had contended that salaries and promotions are based solely on factors that are not sex-related, such as merit, employee qualifications, hiring needs and market conditions.

Frye failed to find enough evidence proving sex discrimination in the salary awarded to the seventh plaintiff, Carol Brownlow.

The other plaintiffs in the case were Lenore Campbell, Jean Ferguson, Margaret Hiatt, Wilma Hein, Gloria McFadden and Jacquelyn Rice.

A class action suit alleging sex discrimination filed on behalf of all the women faculty members in the state's eight colleges and universities against the State Board of Higher Education is still pending.
