

# Local racism--not just in the South

"Racism in Eugene... is the same as racism in Alabama," said Manuel Pacheco, director of the University high school equivalency program.

Pacheco, along with four others, took part in a panel discussion on racism sponsored by the Eugene chapter of Clergy and Laity Concerned.

"Racism is institutionalized in our society," Pacheco said. Given the occasion, he cautioned, overtly racist acts will occur.

Racist acts are occurring continually in the area, said Gorham. He pointed out that the absence of local media coverage does not mean such acts aren't happening.

Incidents cited by the panel point out racial graffiti on dormitory walls, Indian parties at a local restaurant where waitress's don traditional Native American costumes and police harassment of Black youths, are, in Kent Gorham's words "just the tip of the iceberg." Gorham is a human rights specialist for the City of Eugene.

Racist activities, like those cited by the panel, are often "swallowed up" and are overlooked by society, said Misa Joo, of the Eugene minorities council.

Joo, a Eugene school teacher as well as minority activist, said she believes children are taught racism at a very young age.

She noted the materials used in education reflects the inherent racism in our culture.

Joo also said that racism hasn't changed much in 40 years. She cited the incarceration of Japanese Americans during World War II as a prime example.

"The legal basis by which this happened still exists," Joo warned.

She calls all minorities to unity in finding a solution to their oppression.

Blacks, as well as other minorities, are still suffering blatant inadequacies in everyday-

America, said Patricia Creal, director of LCC's multi-cultural center.

Racism is spreading and must be dealt with, Creal stressed, adding the best way to combat it is through education.

"We need to educate each other that racism is still on the move - we need to erase racism from our vocabularies and our hearts."

Racism is an unavoidable aspect of everyday life for the Native American, said Maria Tenorio, of the Indian child welfare project.

"To our people it's a fact of

life... it pervades everything."

One member of the audience spoke up to say she did not experience overt racism until she moved to Eugene from the east coast 10 years ago.

The woman, who wished to remain anonymous for fear of retaliation, said "I never had a cross burned on my lawn until I moved to Lane County."
