# KWAX seeks 911 benefactors

KWAX radio's semi-annual "friend-raiser" fundraiser of-

ficially began Monday at 8 p.m. as the radio inaugurated its push to "raise 911 friends," at an average contribution of \$25, says station manager Janet

Kenney.

Operating with a \$180,000 budget, KWAX has already included the anticipated \$20,000 from this fundraiser in its budget, she says.

The funds will go towards general expenses in the budget — tapes, records, equipment repair, utility costs, and other items, Kenney says.

"The sooner we get our goal, the sooner we'll stop pitching," Kenney says. Various cultural leaders from the University and community will be on the air probably for about nine days, she adds.

Programming otherwise will not be that different, Kenney says.

Notable exceptions will be a special "Prairie Home Companion" broadcast from 8 p.m. to 1 a.m. March 6, and a King Singers concert March 9.

"The potential is out there," he says. Individuals can make a difference by doing their part, Guehler adds.

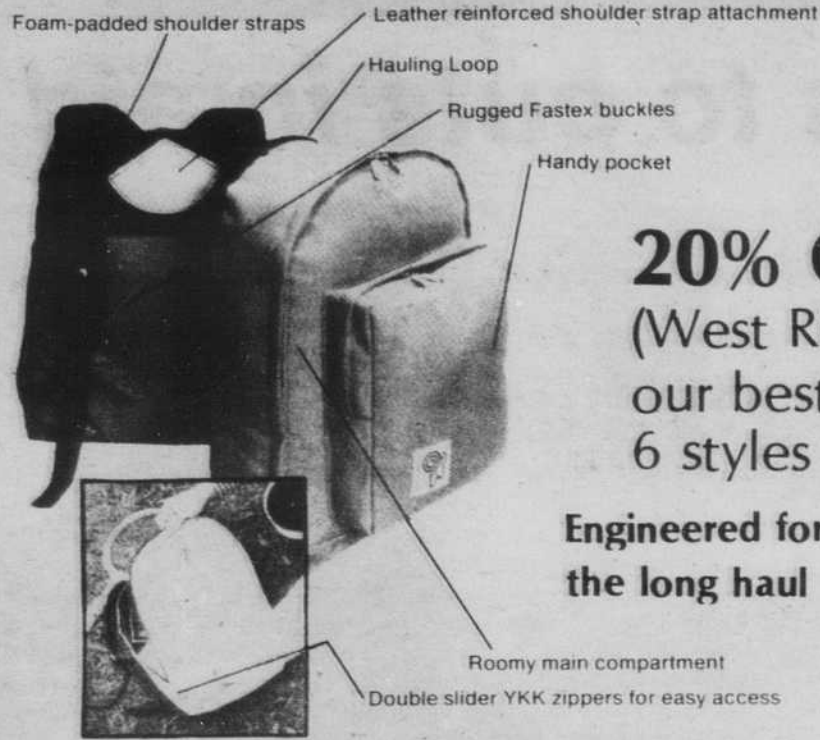

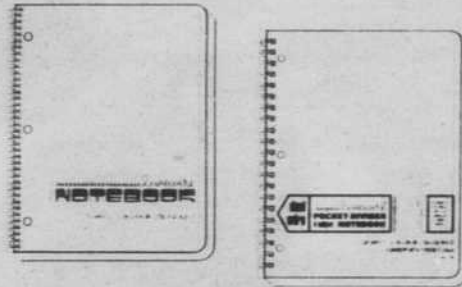
