# Kentucky upset in NCAAs

Rick Campbell scored 19 points and Middle Tennessee overcame a rash of missed free throws down the stretch in a 50-44 upset over 15th-ranked Kentucky to highlight NCAA regional first-round games Thursday night.

In the region's first game, Steve Bouchie and Ted Kitchel each scored six straight points in the first five minutes as defending national champion Indiana bolted to a quick, 10-point advantage and went on to smash Robert Morris 94-62.

Forward Russel Todd scored 20 points and five teammates also finished in double figures as 14th-ranked West Virginia crushed North Carolina A & T 102-72 in the first game of the West Regional.

Southern California was upset by Wyoming 61-58 in the second game.

West Virginia advanced to the second round here Saturday against 11th-ranked Fresno State, the region's fourth-seeded team.

Hot-shooting Rob Williams ignited Houston's fast-break attack with 25 points as the Cougars eliminated Alcorn State 94-84 in the first round of

the Midwest Regional.

Houston advanced to the second round to face No. 10 Tulsa Saturday. Marquette earned the right to meet No. 5 Missouri Saturday with a 67-62 win over Evansville in the other Midwest first-round game at Oral Roberts University.

Reserve forward Anthony Teachey and starter Mike Helms scored 18 points each Thursday night to pace No. 18 Wake Forest to a 74-57 victory over Old Dominion in a first-round game of the East Regional.

The Demon Deacons will meet Memphis State Saturday in second-round action. Top-ranked North Carolina faces James Madison in the second round after the Dukes rallied to down Ohio State 55-48.

Dean Marquardt scored 21 points, including key free throws in the closing seconds, as Marquette beat Evansville 67-62 in the first round of the Midwest Regional.

Marquette turned back a late Evansville rally to run its record to 23-8 and advance to a second-round regional game against No. 5 Missouri Saturday.

## Duck matmen 13th after opening round

**AMES, Iowa** — Four of the nine Oregon wrestlers entered in the NCAA championships are still in the running after Thursday's preliminary rounds.

Oregon as a team was 13th after the first round.

Mike Erb, Bill Nugent, Barry Boyles and Dan Cook each kept their hopes alive, while Miles Hancock, Cliff Porter, Rick O'Shea, Keith Beutler and Lance Hohanadel could not survive preliminaries.

Porter beat John Moser of Westchester 5-4 in the pigtail round at the 134-pound class, but lost to Bobby Williams of Arizona State in the preliminary round.

Erb, wrestling at 118, defeated Jami Kasser of Clarion State 6-4. Nugent beat Robert Preston 5-4 at 142. Boyles pinned Andrew Karas from Weber State in the 150-pound class, and heavyweight Cook beat Bill Sabo of Old Dominion 6-1.

Nugent, seeded fifth in the tournament, goes on to face Adam Cohen of Arizona State, and Cook will face No. 3 seed Steve Williams of Oklahoma next.
