

# Celebrities cycle, pantomime their way to Canton, China

**HONG KONG (AP)** — A group of Hollywood celebrities returned to Hong Kong Tuesday after bicycling in China for 18 days, and said it was the only way to see the country.

"It was a wonderful experience," said singer-dancer Ben Vereen.

"I would like to go back, preferably on bike again," actress Kate Jackson added.

The group, including actor Lorne Green, flutist Paul Horn,

former Miss U.S.A. Lindsay Bloom and her husband, Mayf Nutter, and mime Mark Wenzel, only covered a tiny part of China — from the nearby Portuguese colony of Macao to Canton.

The trip was billed "Cycling Through China" by television producer Charles Jennings for a 90-minute program to be shown this fall.

The group entered China March 12 and pedaled the 400-odd mile journey through several Chinese villages. At each village, they performed for Chinese audiences as well as for their own filming.

Wenzel, who rode a unicycle part of the way, found himself especially useful because the language barrier forced the group to "practically pantomime our way through China," he said.

## A Bee Gee dries out

**LONDON (AP)** — Maurice Gibb of the Bee Gees is a former alcoholic who was dried out in California and still attends meetings of Alcoholics Anonymous, his mother, Barbara Gibb, said in an interview published Tuesday in Woman magazine.

Mrs. Gibb, originally from Lancashire in northern England and now living in Los Angeles, said Maurice "had an awful time with drink. He was done (arrested) for drunk driving two or three times. I remember he had a Rolls Royce in London and he could barely see past the steering wheel..."

Maurice, 32, took the cure a year ago after going to a clinic in Santa Barbara, Calif., and hasn't touched a drop since, she said.

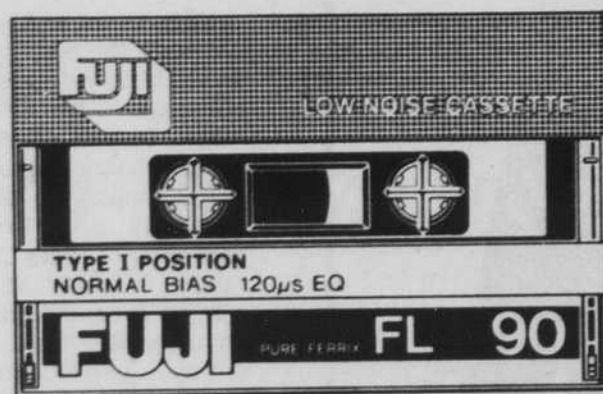
