Youth offered summer academics, athletics

Two new programs are among 18 academic and sports offerings for young people at the University this summer.

Students now completing their sophomore and junior years in high school will be chosen this spring for the new Summer Science Experience July 12-23. Students will explore research activities in biology, chemistry, geology and physics through lab work, lectures and field trips.

The cost of the program is set at \$200 for everything but meals and transportation to and from campus. However, Gordon Murphy, an administrative assistant in the biology department,

says he hopes that amount will be lowered from supplementary funding, such as grants.

In the new Global Studies Enrichment Program set June 27-July 10, young people entering grades nine through 12 can learn about foreign policy and issues such as the relationship of rich and poor nations. The cost of the program is \$93.

Both the science and global studies programs require students to commute each weekday to the campus.

The new programs join such popular summer activities as the Family Vacation College, the Summer Enrichment Program for Gifted and Talented Students and the High School Summer Music Session, offered annually since 1947.

Seven sports camps are planned, ranging from Rich Brooks' Football Camp (\$145 to \$185, depending on whether the participant stays in the dorms) to Chris Voelz's Volleyball Camp (\$75 to \$155, depending on living arrangements and number of meals purchased). Other sports camps will focus on basketball, track, wrestling and tennis. Cheerleading and drill team camps are also scheduled.

Other summer programs include Beaver Boys' State, Upward Bound, a program in forensics and a workshop for those wishing to become sailing and canoeing instructors.

Kennedy, Vance Jr., get like jobs

NEW YORK (AP) — Robert F. Kennedy Jr. and Cyrus Vance Jr. will become assistant district attorneys in the office of Manhattan District Attorney Robert Morgenthau in August.

The sons of the late Robert F. Kennedy and former U.S. Secretary of State Cyrus Vance "came in cold" to the office, with no recommendations from anybody, Manhattan District Attorney Robert Morgenthau says. They passed through the office's usual hiring process, winning praise "at each step of the way," he said.

Kennedy, 28, and Vance, 27, will be part of a group of about 50 new assistants joining the office this summer.

Morgenthau said Monday that all new prosecutors in his office are hired strictly on merit, and he thought highly of Kennedy and Vance or he "wouldn't have hired them."

Kennedy, a son of the assassinated New York senator, and Vance, whose father served the Carter administration and is now in private law practice here, will be paid the office's starting salary of \$20,000 a year.
