Oregon's weather began improving slowly Wednesday as a high pressure system established itself over the Pacific Northwest, according to the

weather service. That spells relief from the occasional showers Tuesday night and early Wednesday that

dropped two-tenths of an inch of rain along the Oregon Coast and scattered showers on parts of the interior valleys. The service said snow showers were possible in the Cascades and in Eastern Oregon later Wednesday. A drying trend that began in the northern portion of the state today was expected to extend to Southern Oregon by tonight or Thursday.
