Hansen wins city council seat

Dick Hansen defeated Susan Sowards for the Ward 4 Eugene City Council seat, which includes the area around the University, by a slim margin Tuesday night.

Hansen, the 47-year-old general manager of Valley River Center, held the lead throughout the evening and won the seat — previously held by Gretchen Miller — by a final vote of 1919 to 1496.

As city councilor, Hansen says he'll work to send "a very clear signal" to draw outside businesses to Eugene.

Hansen currently serves on the Economic Diversification Team and the Lane Transit District budget committee and has served on numerous

city committees.

Sowards, who campaigned heavily at the University, said she was disappointed in the poor voter turnout at the University.

Voter turnout at the University, which comprises a good portion of Ward 4, could have been higher if the candidates in the hotly contested gubernatorial race had campaigned on campus more, Sowards said.

Sowards, a partner in Business Development Associates, said she'll campaign for state Rep. Margie Hendricksen's re-election to District 40 and Larry Hill, a state representative candidate for District 42, Springfield.

Weaver, Anthony, post wins

Jim Weaver whipped opponent Gene Arvidson Tuesday for the 4th District Democratic congressional nomination, while Republican Ross Anthony sailed unopposed into the final election in November.

Weaver, 54, and pursuing his fifth term in the House, gained 72 percent of the Democratic vote. Arvidson, considered a long-shot, finished a distant second with 14 percent. A 51-year-old Creswell equipment salesman, Arvidson two years ago finished fifth in a field of five Democratic candidates for the U.S. Senate.

"I don't know why he chose to run, but he's a nice man," Weaver said of Arvidson at Harris Hall in Eugene Tuesday night.

"I feel very good, but of course the tough one will be in the fall. I fail to see how a Republican candidate can go against everything a Republican president stands for," Weaver said.

Throughout the campaign, Weaver ignored Arvidson and concentrated on Anthony, a 36-year-old economics professor on leave from the University.

At his campaign headquarters in the Eugene Hotel, Anthony said he expects the main issue in the upcoming campaign to be who can get the economy moving again.

"Jim Weaver will be a very tough opponent, but we have a good campaign and it will point out the lack of effective leadership of the incumbent, Anthony said.
