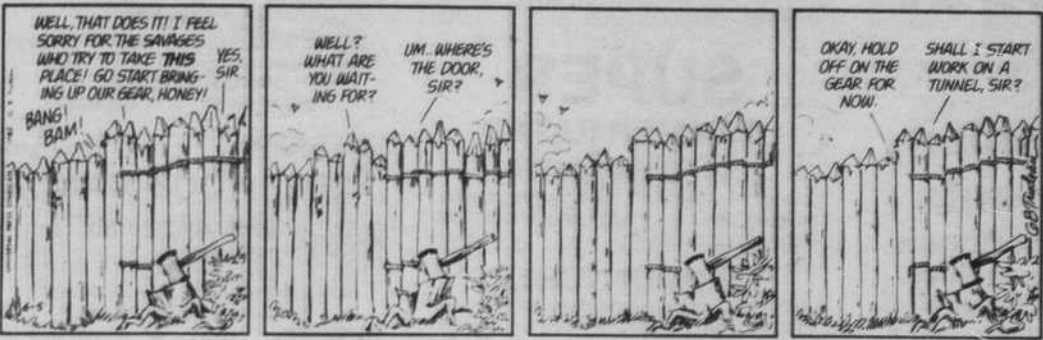
Inter-Varsity Christian Fellowship will hold its final meeting of the year tonight at 7 at the Wesley Center.

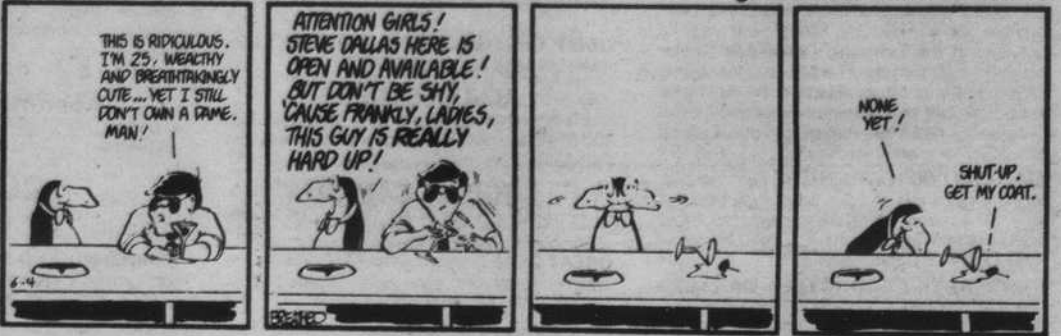
