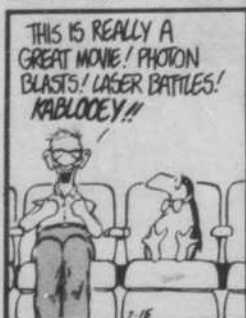
CULTURAL
