

English prof given grant for research

Donald S. Taylor, a University English professor, is among 97 scholars from all over the nation this year to be awarded a grant-in-aid for post-doctoral research from the American Council of Learned Societies. His research will focus on the relevance of R. G. Collingwood's artistic and historical thought to literary history and

criticism. Taylor, who earned his doctoral degree at the University of California, Berkeley, in 1950, came to the University in 1968. Before coming to Eugene, he was director of graduate students in English at the University of Washington. In 1972, Taylor received a fellowship from the John Simon

Ruggenheim Memorial Foundation. Taylor used that fellowship to work on a literary history of the 18th century English writer Thomas Chatterton. He did his research at Oxford University in England. Taylor edited "The Complete Works Of Thomas Chatterton," published in 1971.

Taylor has also been awarded a \$2,500 University Faculty Research Award this summer to study Collingwood's theories. The American Council of Learned Societies' grants have been made available by donations from the Ford Foundation and the National Endowment for the Humanities.
