If you want live music at a jumpin' tavern, cheap drinks until you pass out, or just a quite place to visit and drink with friends, say no more. Here is the 1982 Oregon Daily Emerald's "all inclusive" bar guide for the University area.

Daily, 11:30-2 a.m.
Draft beer starts at 70 cents a glass, pitchers \$3; bottled beer \$1-\$1.35; wine \$1.25 glass, \$3.25 half liters, \$4.75 liter.

Specials: Happy hour 4-6 p.m. daily, glasses 60 cents, pitchers \$2.50; Tuesday "Ladies Night," half price beer and wine; Thursday "Import Night," \$1 for all imported bottled beer.

Food: lunch served from 11:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Soups, sandwiches and salads.

Entertainment: "the best live music in town," nightly (rock'n'roll, some reggae and jazz), \$1.50-\$3 cover; pool tables and video games.

In the last two months B J Kelly's has lowered their cover and pitcher prices, installed air-conditioning and beefed up their image as a fun place to party and listen to live music any night of the week. The clientele ranges from 21-30 years old.

Draft beer 65 cents to \$1.25; bottled beer \$1-\$1.60 (50 kinds of imported beer); wine \$1.25 per glass.

Food: lunch and dinner (chicken, soup, crepes, quiche) and after 9 p.m. hot and cold appetizers.

Entertainment: video games, darts, back-

gammon and a large wall-library.

DeFrisco's has a friendly atmosphere where students and local business people come to talk, relax, and drink from the large selection of imported beers. According to manager Gill Shaw, people are trying imported beers the same way they try mixed drinks — they savor each bottle and like to experiment from the large imported beer selection.

Draft beer 50-65 cents; bottled beer 90 cents to \$1.40; pitchers \$2.75-\$3.50, and wine.

Food: lunch (soup, salads and sandwiches) and snacks.

Entertainment: rock'n'roll Friday and Saturday nights; pool tables and video games; and a big screen television.

Duffy's is one of the main gathering places for University students, who make up 90 percent of the clientele.

Food: the restaurant menu is also provided in the bar.

Entertainment: country-western bands seven nights a week, no cover.

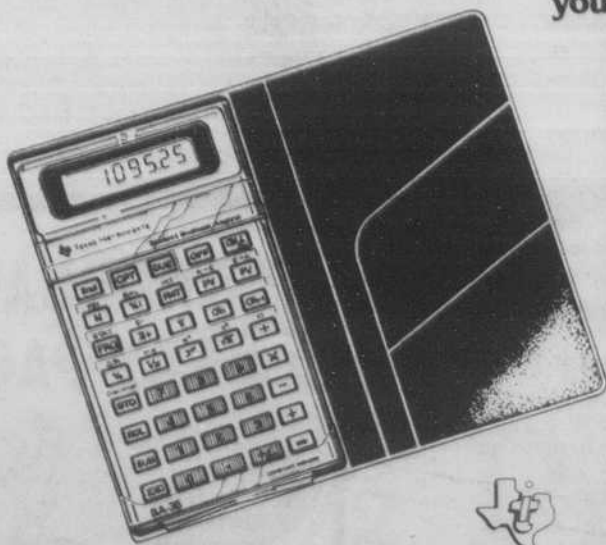


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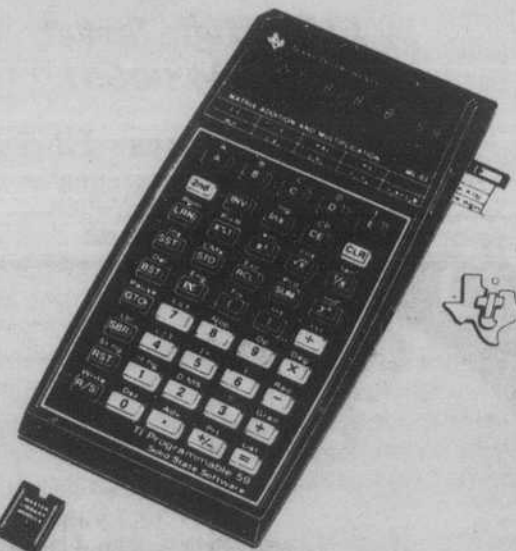
