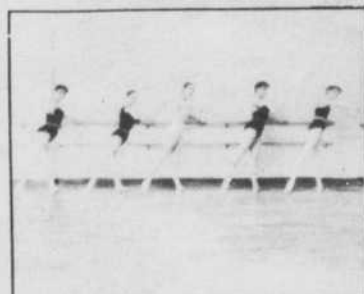


EUGENE SCHOOL OF BALLET

Entertainment: live music (top-40 rock) six nights a week, \$2 cover (half cover before 10 p.m.) and no cover Sundays.

Food: breakfast (a big breakfast for \$1.60) and lunch.

Entertainment: live music (rock'n'roll and blues) Friday and Saturday nights, \$1-\$2 cover.

Taylor's is a familiar campus landmark and has recently done some remodeling. Although small, when there is live music the place is packed with students.

Specials: Sunday — happy hour on beer; Tuesday starting at 8 p.m. hot dogs are sold for 25 cents; Friday, 4-8 p.m. wine on sale per glass.

Food: sandwiches, soups and salads.

Entertainment: four pool tables, video and pinball games, three televisions with 40 some channels, including a big screen television.

The atmosphere at the Pad is "open and friendly" — it's a neighborhood tavern. The clientele (students, local residents, doctors, blue-collar workers) consider it their bar and so they take care of it, a Pad employee says.
