Bent slouched up the stairs to the main floor and there found a sprawling expanse of lounges and eateries.

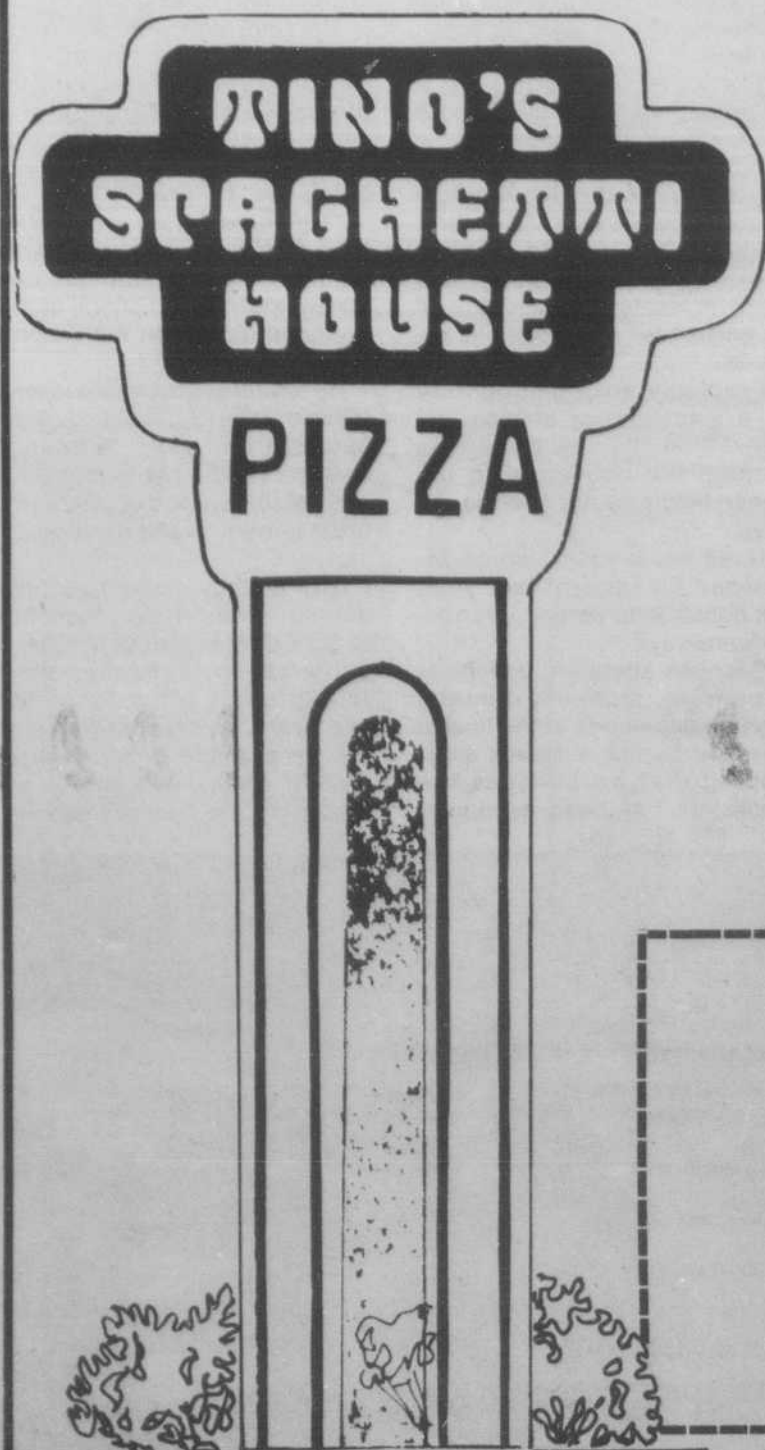
