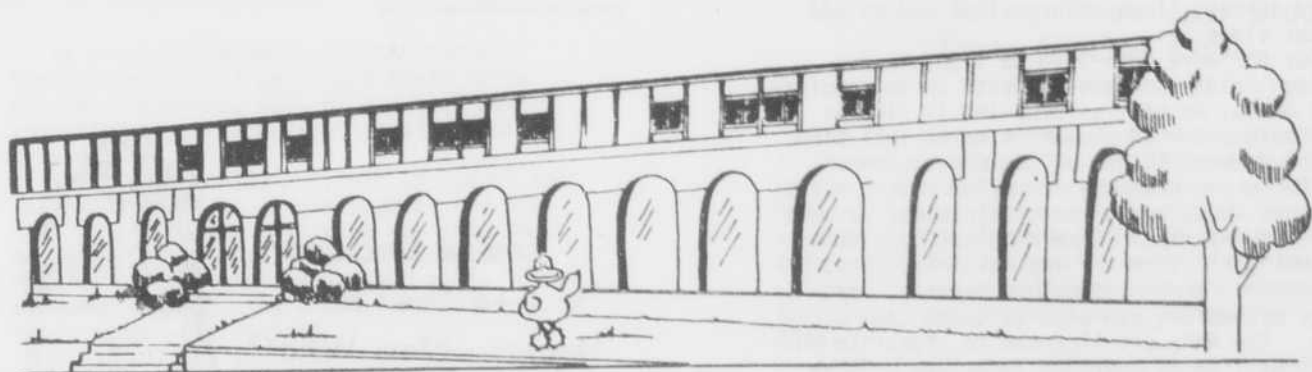

The Student Health Center Can Meet Your Primary Health Needs

Most students don't plan to get sick or injured while they are attending the University. However, if that happens to you, the health center is available to diagnose and treat your illness or injury. The health center is staffed by physicians, nurse practitioners, and nurses who can meet your primary health needs. This includes diagnosis and treatment of such problems as respiratory infections, skin diseases, bladder and kidney infections, infectious diarrheas, mononucleosis, strep throat, headaches, fatigue, stress, sprains, and lacerations. The health center has specialists in internal medicine, allergy, and psychiatry, as well as a Women's Clinic and a Sports Medicine Clinic.
