# Oregon takes first NorPac win

## Beat WSU Drop to UW

As expected, the Oregon women's volleyball team encountered some tall timber this weekend in matches against Washington and Washington State, coming away with a split.

The Huskies defeated Oregon 15-9, 15-13, 15-7, but Ducks came back to beat WSU 15-4, 15-6, 12-15, 15-8 and record their first NorPac conference win against three losses.

On Friday, the Ducks were up against a huge UW front line. Voelz had expressed concern beforehand about the powerful front threesome of Lynn Poelstra (6-3), Becky Stone (6-1) and Abby Lyons (6-1). Those concerns were well-founded as the trio wore Oregon down. Poelstra had 16 kills, Stone 13 and Lyons 9. Washington relied on the setting of Starry Suttich to set up the kills.

"Those three girls were very good," said Oregon coach Chris Voelz. "And I was really impressed with their setter."

The Ducks were not without their chances. Leading 5-0 and 7-3 in the first game, and the score was tied 9-9 later. However, Washington ran out the game with six straight points.

In the second game, the Ducks led 5-3 early on, and 13-11 late in the game, only to watch the Huskies run off four

straight points. Senior Anetta Ensworth was particularly impressive for Oregon, recording several key blocks.

Washington then ran off 10 consecutive points to start the third game and held on to deal the Ducks their third NorPac loss and sixth straight on the season.

"We just can't make all those errors," said a disappointed Voelz. "We started reading their hits better later in the match, but we should have been on top of them better — I take part of the blame for that. We just have to play better, and the girls can't get deflated."

It might have been easy for the Ducks to do. They lost the services of starter Ronda Dalthorp, who went down early in the first game with a sprained ankle, continuing the Ducks' injury woes. Dalthorp joined Shaunna Koenig, out with a hand injury, on the injury list. But, Oregon was bolstered by the return of Stephanie Tambe, back from a sprained arm.

The Ducks bounced back on Saturday to handily defeat WSU, but they did it the hard way. Oregon won the first two games easily, as Sue Harbour did everything but hand out popcorn. Harbour served well, had several kills (12 for the match) and some timely blocks.

However, the Cougars rebounded to win game three, 15-12, and they led 7-0 in game four before a fired up Connie Riel led a Ducks comeback that sealed a 15-8 win. "Riel had the

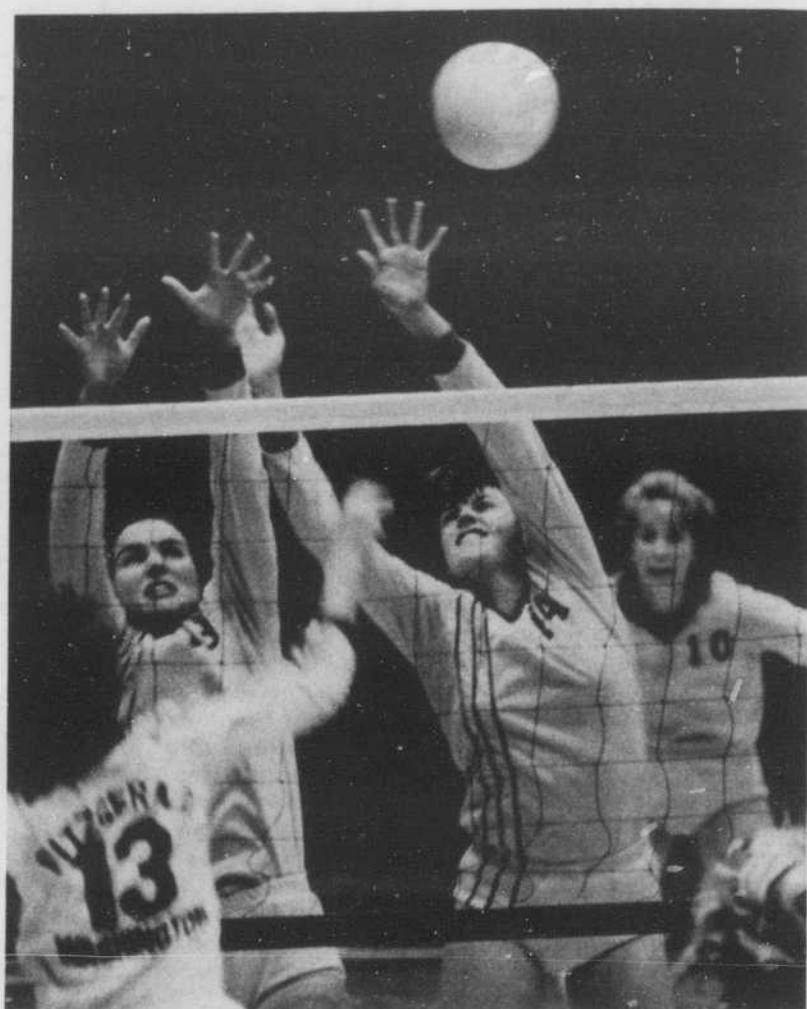

kills when we needed them," said Voelz. "She was a real spark."

It was a relieved Voelz who watched Oregon up its record to 1-3 and 8-7, ending a six-match losing streak. "It's a relief," said

Voelz, "because for a while we really had a thorn in our side. When you're losing, you really start to wonder, and when they won that third game, the girls were probably thinking 'Oh no'."
