**Israel and Lebanon open troop withdrawal talks**

**WASHINGTON (AP)** — Israel and Lebanon are expected to open negotiations this week — with the United States present — on talks aimed at producing an operational plan for an Israeli military withdrawal from Lebanon, a senior U.S. official said Monday.

The official said the talks could begin as early as the end of this week and would constitute an important step in the U.S. objective for the removal of all foreign forces — Israeli, Syrian and the Palestine Liberation Organization — from Lebanon by the end of the year.

He also reported that special U.S. envoy Morris Draper was sent back to the Middle East but was temporarily taken out of the diplomatic action after developing a kidney stone during a stopover in London.

Nonetheless the official, who spoke on the airliner bringing Secretary of State George P. Shultz home from a meeting with Canadian officials in Ottawa, said that the United States believes that even without Draper's presence the talks will begin this week.

The official, who stipulated that he not be identified by name, said there is now a need to concentrate on the talks on the creation of a security zone to protect northern Israel, which often was shelled by PLO forces inside Lebanon.

He noted that Lebanese President Amin Gemayel has called for an immediate pullback of Israeli forces from their current positions as a sign of good faith, and he said U.S. officials "think that is a good idea if it can be brought off."

**Violence erupts between rival religious factions**

**BELFAST, Northern Ireland (AP)** — Extremists bludgeoned a Roman Catholic kidnap victim to death and gunned down another Catholic in the city of Armagh Monday in apparent retaliation for the kidnapping of a Protestant militiaman.

Police said the mutilated body of Joseph Donegan, 48, father of seven, was found slumped in a back alley in Belfast's Shankill Road district, a heartland of Protestant militancy. The killers used a knife and blunt instrument to damage Donegan's face beyond recognition, but a gold watch he was wearing

helped his family identify the body, police said.

A short time later, Peter Corrigan, 47, a campaign worker for the Irish Republican Army's legal Sinn Fein political wing, was shot to death as he walked to a local welfare office in Armagh, near the border with the Irish Republic. Corrigan had 11 children.

Police said they fear that Protestant militiaman Thomas Cochrane, 55, abducted three days ago by Provisional IRA guerrillas in the border county of South Armagh, may have been killed.

Police said three men have been detained for questioning in the Donegan kidnap-slaying. No details were immediately available.

Monday's deaths followed a month-long series of retaliatory sectarian slayings during the buildup to last week's election of a new 78-seat provincial assembly. In the vote last Wednesday, both Protestant and Catholic hardliners made strong showings.

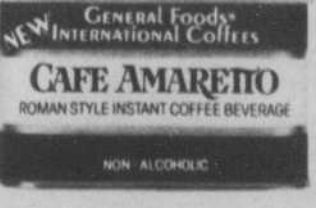

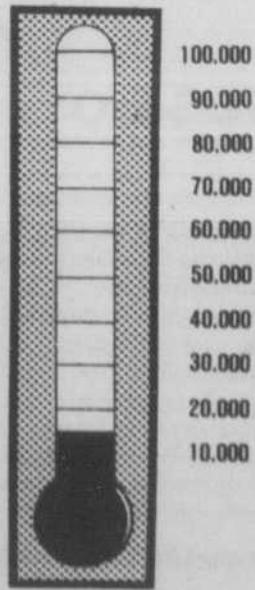
