

Brezhnev calls for unity against U.S. adventurism

MOSCOW (AP) — Pres. Leonid Brezhnev, in an unusual meeting of senior military and Kremlin officials Wednesday, urged a military buildup and better ties with China to counter what he called U.S. adventurism. Brezhnev reasserted his role as commander-in-chief of the Soviet armed forces, heaped praise on Defense Minister Dimitri Ustinov and hinted that reorganization may be under way in defense industries — the responsibility of Andrei Kirilenko who has been rumored to have retired due to failing health. The official Soviet news agency Tass said

Brezhnev called the meeting at the request of Ustinov, who was one of five members of the ruling Politburo attending. The 76-year-old Kirilenko, who had been considered a strong contender to succeed Brezhnev, was absent. Two other possible successors, ex-KGB chief Yuri Andropov and Konstantin Chernenko, sat on Brezhnev's right; Foreign Minister Andrei Gromyko and Premier Nikolai Tikhonov sat at his left and Ustinov was seated behind him. Western diplomats said they were unable to explain

the timing and purpose of the meeting, but they said they believed it was to underscore the unity of Brezhnev's "collective leadership" and its close ties with the Red Army. The speech lasted 10 minutes and was televised. The 75-year-old leader read the speech in a strong voice, but badly slurred much of it. Cameras avoided Brezhnev as he walked to and from the podium. Brezhnev said that "Washington's aggressive policy... is threatening to push the world into the flames of nuclear war."

Holy Shiites, what a 'celebration'

NABATIYEH, Lebanon (AP) — Shiite Moslems split their scalps with razor blades, then beat them with swords to increase the bleeding Wednesday in a traditional observance of the death 13 centuries ago of one of their holiest martyrs. Thousands chanted before the main mosque in this center of the Shiite faith in Lebanon as the scalps of men, boys and dozens of male babies in their mothers' arms were sliced open

on top, where they had been shaved, with several quick, chopping motions with a straight razor. A few women and girls also took part. Then the men and boys beat their bleeding heads with the flat edges of curved swords as they marched in lines around the square. Torrents of blood poured down their faces and onto the white sheets that covered their bodies. Mothers patted the bleeding heads of their babies with their

hands, keeping time with the men. One of the babies sucked on a pacifier. The celebration, called Ashura, marks the death of Imam Hussein in a battle at Karbala, Iraq, in the year 680. Shiite tradition has it that Iraqis encouraged Hussein to lay claim to the caliphate of Islam, then failed to support him and thus were responsible for his death. With about 950,000 adherents, the Shiites are the largest Moslem sect in Lebanon, and Ashura rites were held in several other towns. But the largest and most frenzied was at Nabatiyeh, in south central Lebanon. Many in the March wore pendants displaying the portrait of Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini.

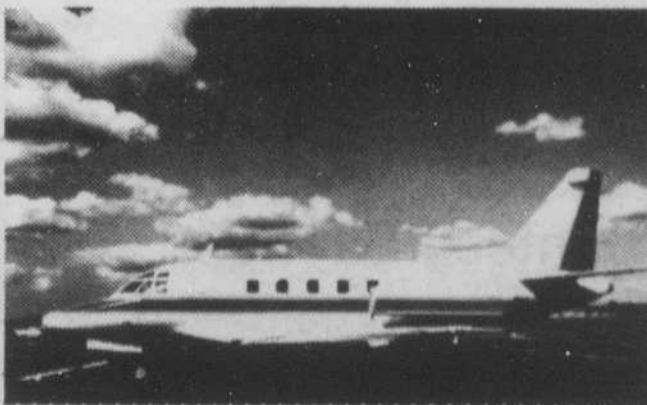

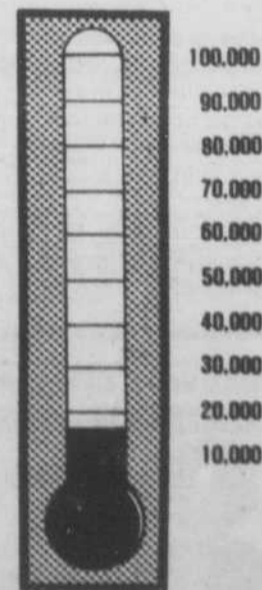
