Students for a Nuclear Free Future (SNUFF) will be holding a meeting tomorrow at 5 p.m. in 112 EMU. All are welcome.

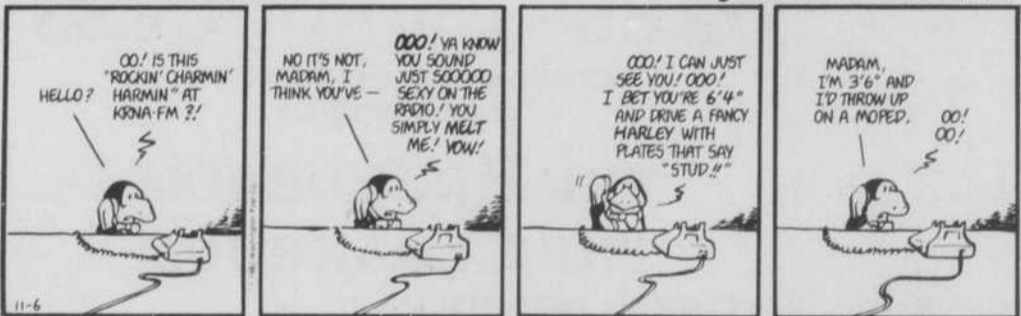
