the Kremlin dispatched the first of some 85,000 troops to neighboring Afghanistan in an effort to quell Moslem resistance to that country's Marxist regime.

Following the intervention, the U.S. Senate refused even to consider the SALT II treaty, and Ronald Reagan, who defeated Carter in the 1980 presidential election, said it had to be renegiated.

Clearly ill at ease in formal

speeches and ceremonies, the 200-pound Brezhnev could be warm and confident with small groups ranging from factory workers to foreign statesmen.

But before the Soviet public, his sobriety and reserve dovetailed into such personal secretiveness that most Soviet citizens had no idea even how many children their leader had.

Even Soviet parlor jokes reflected Brezhnev's image as a stiff, careful man. In one com-

mon variation, Brezhnev was awakened by a knock on his door at night. He went to the door, put on his glasses, drew a paper from his bathrobe pocket and read out, "Who's there?"

Brezhnev was sometimes less formal on foreign trips, when his wife, Viktoria, was also most frequently seen in public. To foreigners, he even revealed a few personal hobbies and interests: fast cars, hunting and new electronic gadgets.

Three inmates indicted on drug charges, from inside county jail

GRANTS PASS, (AP) — Three people have been indicted on drug-related charges following a two-month investigation into marijuana smuggling among inmates at the Josephine County Jail.

Bruce McFarland, 32, of Cave

Junction, was arraigned Wednesday on a charge of delivering a controlled substance on Aug. 28. Robert Elliott, 28, of Grants Pass, was charged with criminal conspiracy to deliver a controlled substance between Aug. 1 and Nov. 2.

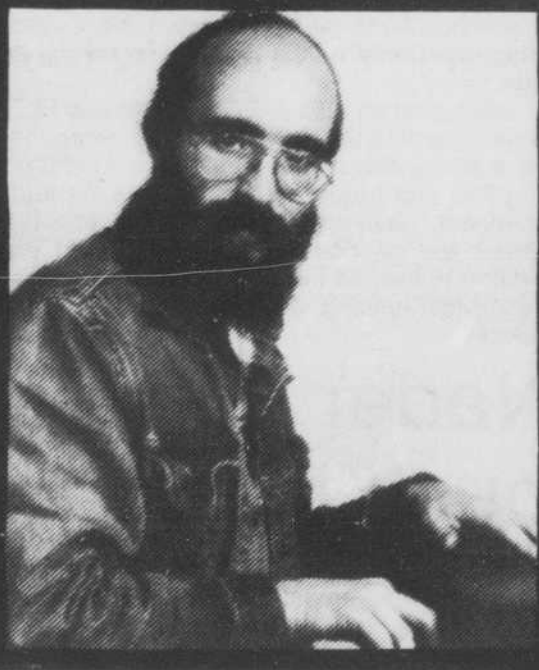
A third secret indictment was issued in the case, authorities said, but the suspect was not identified.

Elliott is one of several inmate trustees suspected of smuggling as many as 20 marijuana-filled balloons per day into the jail during the past three months. The total amount of marijuana involved is not known.

Detectives believe trustees who worked outside the jail picked up the balloons at a pre-arranged spot and brought them into the jail hidden in their rectums.

Detectives suspect that other trustees working inside the jail delivered the marijuana to McFarland, also an inmate.

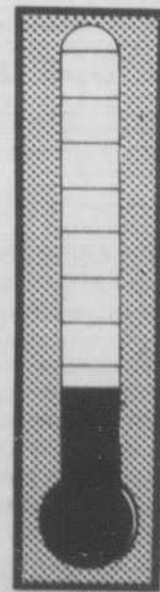
