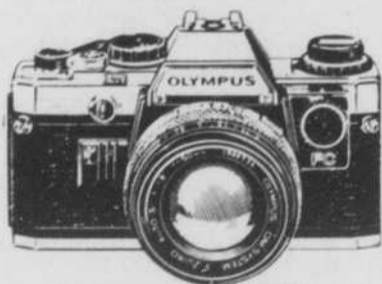

## Recycling state bills increases

SALEM (AP) — Oregon may be the biggest timber-producing state in the United States, but that hasn't stopped state officials from trying to save a few trees. Paper recycling has become fashionable in state government.

The 1983 Legislature will be the first to write its hundreds of bills entirely on recycled paper.

In recent years, state agencies have doubled the amount of paper they recycle to about 100 tons a month, equivalent to about 17 trees.

The paper is delivered to the Garten Foundation, a nonprofit group employing mentally retarded people. Garten recycles the paper, takes some of the proceeds for its own use and returns the rest to state government.

The state earns between \$700 and \$1,000 a month from sales. It saves another \$1,500 a month by not having to lug discarded paper to the Marion County landfill, General Services Department officials estimate.

By law, the state must buy recycled paper whenever possible. Oregon was among the first states to require such extensive bureaucratic recycling, beginning in 1973.

## 'Doo-dah' dancers parade in Pasadena

PASADENA, Calif. (AP) — Cone-headed bathing beauties, dancing cigarette packs and MX missiles pranced through old Pasadena on Sunday in the zaniness known as the Doo-Dah Parade.

It was billed as an event with no theme, no judging, no prizes and no order.

Its lead-off banner read, "The Doo Dah Parade. World Rights Reserved. Any resemblance to other parades living or dead is purely coincidental!"

The spoof on Pasadena's annual Rose Bowl parade drew an estimated 40,000 spectators to cheer on about 100 entries.

Zeke the Sheik from Mozambique marched with a cactus plant on his head and a white toga wrapped around his body. He said he was running for governor, senator, president or whatever.

The Cancerettes dressed as cigarette packs.

Prancing down the street wearing shower curtains was the drill team called "Keep It Clean." They wore shower caps and carried shower brushes and spray bottles to squirt spectators.

"Ladies Against Women," attired in early 20th-century garb that covered them from head to toe, hoisted banners that read "Cruise Missiles Not Bars," "Any Girl Who Calls Herself a Woman is no Lady," and "You're Nobody Until You're Mrs. Somebody."
