

Kell gets life in bomb death

EUGENE (AP) — Michael Kell, the 20-year-old transient convicted of aggravated murder in the car bomb death of a Springfield millworker, was sentenced Thursday to life in prison.

He must serve at least 20 years before being considered for parole. The life sentence is mandatory under Oregon law.

"I thought the verdict of the jury in this case was the proper verdict," Circuit Judge Douglas Spencer of Lane County said, "and I think the (mandatory sentence) statute is appropriate as well."

Kell was convicted of helping two accomplices, including the victim's wife, plan and plant a bomb in the car of Robert Harris. The car exploded when Harris started the ignition as he left work last Dec. 2.

Spencer said there was no doubt that Kell's involvement in the murder was premeditated.

Also charged with aggravated murder in the case are the victim's 31-year-old wife, Barbara Harris, and 32-year-old Terry James White of Springfield.

Alleged extortioner convicted in six counts of fraud

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (AP) — James Lewis, the alleged Tylenol extortionist who was sought for months in a nationwide manhunt, was convicted Thursday in a separate case of six federal counts of credit card fraud.

A U.S. District Court jury deliberated just over an hour before returning the verdict. No sentencing date was set by Judge Ross Roberts.

Lewis, 36, was charged with fraud in a scheme to obtain credit cards under another person's name from 13 banks and businesses and with using the cards without intending to pay the bills.

He did not testify in the case.

Lewis also faces charges in an alleged attempt to extort \$1 million from the makers of Extra-Strength Tylenol in the wake of seven Chicago-area deaths last fall from cyanide-laced capsules of the pain reliever.

In addition, he is awaiting trial in Kansas City on another charge of giving false information to the Internal Revenue Service to obtain a tax refund.

Salvation Army captain jailed

COQUILLE (AP) — The former head of the Salvation Army in Coos Bay was sentenced to 20 days in jail and fined \$355 Thursday for illegally selling surplus government cheese intended for the poor.

Albert Summerfield, 38, was sentenced in circuit court by Coos County Judge Richard Barron.

Summerfield, who has been relieved of his post by the Salvation Army, pleaded guilty last Friday to two counts of misapplication of entrusted property. He was accused of selling 900 pounds of cheese valued at \$350 to a restaurant manager.

Summerfield was arrested April 14 along with Frank Clark, manager of Duerksen's Restaurant.

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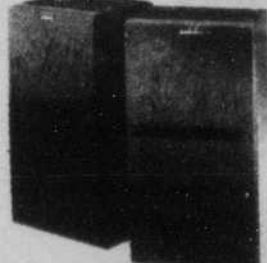
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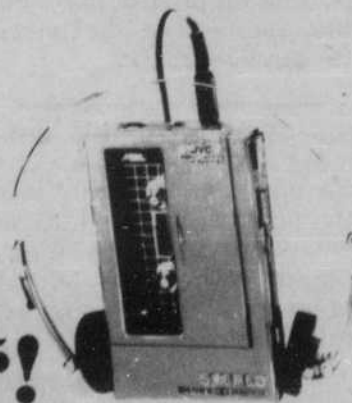
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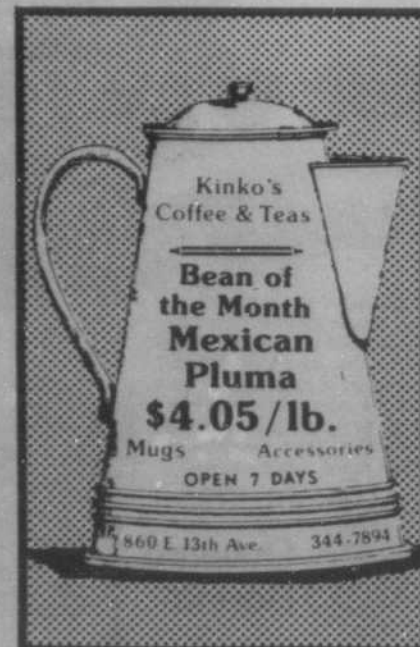
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
